Approval of Advance for Family Services of the Desert

## **BACKGROUND:**

On April 22, 2008 (Agenda #3.24), the Board approved awards for Promoting Safe and Stable Families (PSSF) funding to various vendors throughout the County. One of these vendors was Family Services of the Desert (FSOD). With PSSF funding, FSOD provides Adoption Support Services, Parenting Education, Anger Management and Counseling services to families throughout the desert area, or Zone #3, including Blythe. On December 22, 2009 (Agenda #3.43), the Board approved FSOD for a Child Welfare Services (CWS) award to provide Blythe Counseling and Parenting Education services, and on June 23, 2009 (Agenda #3.41), the Board approved the FSOD award to receive California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids (CalWORKs) funds for Domestic Violence Advocacy Intervention Services for Zone 2 in the Desert area.

Due to the current economic climate, FSOD has requested advances for a total of \$111,400 (25%) to ensure continuity of services for each the six (6) agreement renewals as follows:

DPSS will recapture the advanced funds from FSOD by the end of the Agreement term (June 30, 2011) by offsetting a portion of the monthly billings submitted by FSOD for actual services provided from July 1, 2010 through June 20, 2011.
