WHEREAS, on June 15, 2010, the report was presented to the Board of Supervisors and the Board of Supervisors approved the measure for inclusion on ballot;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside assembled in regular session on July 27, 2010, that pursuant to Elections Code section 9118, the proposed Ordinance, Public Safety and Taxpayer Protection Act of 2010, Requiring a Majority Vote of the Electorate for the Board of Supervisors to Increase or Decrease Retirement Benefits or Pre-Retirement Death Benefits of any Public Safety Employee and Requiring the County of Riverside to Continue the Current CALPERS (California Public Employee Retirement System) Retirement Formula, certified by the Registrar of Voters on May 18,, 2010, shall be submitted to the voters of the County of Riverside at the regular general election to be held on November 2, 2010.
