**SUBJECT:** PURCHASE OF NOVELL SENTINEL MONITORING AND SECURITY SOFTWARE

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:**

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve the proposed purchase of Novell Sentinel Monitoring and Security Software through Enpointe Technologies for an amount not to exceed \$ 95,120.78, with two one-year renewal options.
2. Authorize the Director of the Department of Public Social Services (DPSS) to administer the contract.
3. Authorize the Purchasing Agent, in accordance with Ordinance No. 459, to exercise the renewal options, based on the availability of fiscal funding, and to sign amendments that do not change the substantive terms of the agreement, including amendments to the compensation provision that do not exceed the annual CPI rates.

**SUBJECT: PURCHASE OF NOVELL SENTINEL MONITORING AND SECURITY SOFTWARE**

**BACKGROUND (Continued):**

On April 18, 2010, Request for Quotation (RFQ) DPARC-172 was released to solicit bids to provide Novell Sentinel Monitoring and Security Software. Sentinel is a security event manager used on enterprise data networks to centralize the storage and interpretation of logs, or events, generated by other software running on the network. It is part of an array of solutions to allow us to secure personal identifiable information (PII). DPSS has been tasked to ensure the privacy and security of PII data through an agreement with the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS). DHCS entered into a data sharing agreement with the Social Security Administration from which the PII data requirement originate.

An invitation to bid was sent to the County's awarded software resellers. The County awarded multiple vendors for Novell product through a competitive bid process, and then we compete between those awarded resellers when actual needs arise.

The County received a single bid from Enpointe Technologies.

The price quoted by Enpointe Technologies reflects a 52% discount off of Novell's list price. We also reviewed Novell's California Department of Government Services (DGS) contract. Enpointe's pricing is 3% less than the DGS contract pricing.
