SUBJECT: Approval of the classification and organizational changes relating to the Transportation and Land Management Agency (TLMA) and amend Ordinance No. 440 pursuant to Resolution No. 440-8845.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors adopt the recommendations and amend Ordinance No. 440 pursuant to Resolution No. 440-8845 submitted herewith.

BACKGROUND: TLMA continues to reorganize through downsizing and the consolidation of services in order to resize operations and adjust to ongoing economic challenges. The recommended organizational and classification changes will result in overall salary savings to TLMA's budget and a reduction on overhead costs. TLMA is proposing to restructure its Administrative Services Department by eliminating the TLMA Director of Administration position. Previously the TLMA Administrative Services Department operated by utilizing a Director and a Deputy Director to oversee agency wide administrative functions.

The new organizational structure will provide two (2) Deputy Director positions, both reporting directly to the Agency Director. One (1) Deputy Director will oversee fiscal services for the Agency while the other (1) Deputy Director will be in charge of IT services. The scope of responsibility of any incumbent will be throughout the Agency and its Departments as fiscal services and IT are major divisions supporting Agency staff.

TLMA is proposing an internal Agency-only recruitment to fill these two (2) Deputy Director positions with the intent of reducing the total number of positions through additional consolidation efforts.

TLMA, in conjunction with the Human Resources Department, has reviewed all the existing Deputy Director classifications for TLMA departments and recommends the consolidation and/or elimination of current TLMA Department specific Deputy Director classifications. This includes the Administrative Services, Code Enforcement, Planning and Building & Safety classifications. The TLMA Deputy Director classification will be utilized across TLMA departments.

The intent in utilizing this position throughout the Agency is to make general duties and responsibilities consistent throughout the Agency and its Departments. For those departments that currently have an allocated Deputy Director position, they will be exchanged for a TLMA Deputy Director position. TLMA does not anticipate filling the positions at this time but rather position themselves for the future. The affected departments have sufficient funding to effectuate the recommended actions from departmental budgets.

There is currently one incumbent in the Chief Deputy Planning Director classification. It is recommended that this incumbent be reclassified to the position of TLMA Deputy Director in conjunction with the changes to utilize this classification throughout the Agency and its Departments. This is the only immediate cost of these adjustments for approximately \$5,324.

Further, as part of the consolidation efforts within the Agency, it is recommended that the Assistant Planning Director classification also be eliminated.
