On February 23, 2010 (3.48), the Board adopted Resolution #2010-063, that authorized the Sheriff to apply for \$125,000 in grant funds from the State to continue the specialized patrol program in all five Supervisorial Districts.

In response to the County's application, the California Department of Parks and Recreation has now awarded the Sheriff's Department \$68,577. The grantor requires a County cash or in-kind match of 25% of program costs, or at least \$22,859. The Sheriff's Department will utilize budgeted ROVE car pool expense for the County's in-kind grant match.

Schedule A details budget adjustments in the amount of \$68,577. The grant project term is from 7/1/10 to 6/30/11. County Counsel has approved the Project Agreement as to form.
