authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of street improvements for the Mecca Streets Revitalization Project - Phase 2, including 3rd Street, 4th Street, 5th Street, Coahuilla Street, Date Palm Street, Brown Street, Dale Kiler Road and Hammond Road, in the unincorporated community of Mecca. Bids for the project were opened in the office of the Director of Transportation at 2:00 PM, Wednesday, May 26, 2010. Six bids were received. The Transportation Department's established basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid. The lowest and best total bid was submitted by Hazard Construction in the amount of \$4,067,000. The bid is \$1,633,325 (29%) below the Engineer's Estimate.

As a continuation of the street revitalization in downtown, the Mecca phase 2 project includes improvements on following streets.

The improvements will benefit the property owners, residents and users of these streets. These improvements include, but are not limited to, curb and gutter, street drainage, reconstruction of the existing pavement, road enhancements for pedestrian access, the addition of a sidewalks and the replacement of street lighting.

The proposed work will be funded by the Redevelopment Agency through a cooperative agreement that has been submitted to the Board of Supervisors for execution concurrent with the award of the construction contract.

The project is expected to be completed within the proposed budget, as shown on Attachment "A" which was prepared in coordination with the cooperative agreement.

The contractor has executed the contract and has provided bonds and insurance certificate documents which meet the requirements of the contract.

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into at Riverside, California as of the date set forth below is between County of Riverside hereafter called "County" and **HAZARD CONSTRUCTION COMPANY** hereafter called "Contractor".

W I T N E S S E T H

RECITALS:

1. Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, **MECCA AREA, STREETS REVITALIZATION PROJECT, PHASE-2, Project No. X1005**, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

AGREEMENT:

IT IS AGREED BY THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

1. Contract Documents. The entire contract consists of the following: (a) The Agreement. (b) The Notice Inviting Bids. (c) The Instruction to Bidders. (d) The Contractor's Proposal. (e) The Bid Bond. (f) The Payment Bond. (g) The Performance Bond. (h) The General Conditions. (i) The Special Provisions. (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of May 2006 as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents. (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions. (l) The Plans. (m) Addendas **(1,2 & 3)**. (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Work. (o) Any Change Orders issued. (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Agreement and the Payment Bond and Faithful Performance Bond.
2. The Work. Contractor shall do all things necessary to construct the work generally described in Recital No. 1 in accordance with the Contract Documents.

3. Liquidated Damages and Time of Completion. Attention is directed to the provisions in Section 8-1.06, "Time of Completion", and in Section 8-1.07, "Liquidated Damages", of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

The Contractor shall begin work within 15 days of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of his intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start. If the project has more than one location of work, a separate notice shall be given for each location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by him in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by him at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- (1) The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
- (2) All work done according to the contract prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
- (3) The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".

4. Compensation. Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents. Said Proposal is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of County.
