Each proposal shall be in accordance with Plans, Specifications and other Contract Documents dated September 13, 2010 and prepared by Albert A. Webb Associates, whose address is 3788 McCray St., Riverside, CA 92502. Pursuant to the Labor Code, the Governing Board of the Owner has obtained from the Director of Industrial Relations, State of California, his determinations of general prevailing rates of per diem wages applicable to the work, and for holiday and overtime work, including employee payments or health and welfare, pension, vacation and similar purposes, as set forth on schedule which is on file at the principal office of the Owner, and which will be made available to any interested person upon request.

To be considered, a potential bidder must have a Class A license, as required under provisions of the Public Contracts Code Section 3300, and the California Business and Professions Code, for work covered in its proposal when a bid is submitted. This includes a joint venture formed to submit a bid.

The Contract General Conditions for this project will contain provisions allowing successful contractor to substitute securities for monies withheld by the County to ensure performance (Public Contract Code 22300). A Performance and Payment Bond shall be required for this Project.

FEDERAL FUNDING: This project is being financed with Community Development Block Grant funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (24 CFR Part 570) and subject to certain requirements including: compliance with *Section 3 (24 CFR Part 135)* Economic Opportunities requirements; payment of Federal Davis-Bacon prevailing wages; Federal Labor Standards Provisions (HUD 4010); Executive Order #11246; and others. Information pertaining to the Federal requirements is on file with the County of Riverside Economic Development Agency. The Federal minimum wage rate requirements, as predetermined by the Secretary of Labor, are set forth in the books issued for bidding purposes, referred to herein as Project Bid Documents (Special Federal Provisions), and in copies of this book which may be examined at the office described above where the project plans, special provisions, and proposal forms may be seen. 4. Contractor: Means any entity which performs work in connection with a Section covered project.
5. Lower income resident of the area: A person residing in the Community Development Block Grant project area of the County of Riverside whose annual family income does not exceed eighty (80) percent of the median income. (Calculations are to be based on the median income level as reported by HUD).
6. Project area: In most cases the project area will be bounded by the County limits (or participants' City limits as applicable). However, priority shall be given to persons living within the County's Impact Areas.

III SPECIFIC AFFIRMATIVE ACTION STEPS

In order to comply with Section 3 regulations affirmative action must be taken. This affirmative action will be at least extensive and specific as the following:

- Each contractor and sub-contractor shall incorporate in all contracts for work in connection with a Section 3 covered project the following Section 3 Clause:
