SUBJECT: Ordinance No. 452.228 to establish speed zones enforceable by radar speed detection equipment - Lake Mathews, Moreno Valley, Woodcrest, Eastvale, El Cerrito, Mira Loma, Pedley, Rubidoux, Hemet, Temecula, Bermuda Dunes,

Mecca, Palm Desert, and Thousand Palms areas.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors: Introduce Ordinance No. 452.228, amending Ordinance No. 452 relating to prima facie speed limits to establish various speed zones in the above-referenced areas of Riverside County.

BACKGROUND: Transportation Department staff has conducted Engineering and Traffic Surveys (E&TS) for various roads in the subject areas, as required by the California Vehicle Code.

Based upon the results of the E&TS for these roads, the radar-enforceable speed limits recommended by the Department are summarized in the attached tables.

It is recommended that the Board adopt this amendment at the next regularly scheduled meeting.

County Counsel has approved the ordinance amendment.

Transportation Department staff has contacted the Riverside, San Gorgonio Pass, Temecula, and Indio Area offices of the California Highway Patrol regarding the proposed speed zones.
