### **BACKGROUND:**

As a part of the cooperative agreement for the District's capital improvement projects, both the County of Riverside and Cities within the County typically agree to order the relocation of all utilities installed by permit or franchise within County or City rights of way which conflict with the construction of projects and which must be relocated at the utility owner's expense. However, the District typically bears the relocation cost of conflicting utilities which are either located outside of public rights of way or cannot be ordered to be relocated by County or City at utility owner's expense.

In cases where the District has determined it is advantageous to relocate the conflicting utility prior to project construction, typically, the utility owner is the entity that would be able to design and construct the utility relocation in the most cost effective and timely manner. In addition, utility owners such as Southern California Edison and The Gas Company will not allow other entities or contractors to relocate their facilities.

This recommendation allows the District to complete the relocations in a timely manner with reduced costs.
