Now in its twenty-fifth year, the Red Ribbon Campaign enables communities to create positive peer pressure by visibly encouraging drug-free choices and promoting the standards held by the majority of the people in our county, state and nation: "NO USE OF ILLEGAL DRUGS AND NO ILLEGAL USE OF LEGAL DRUGS."
