RESOLUTION NO. 2010-289

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE (LAFCO 2009-32-2) SETTING THE JURUPA VALLEY REORGANIZATION FOR ELECTION

WHEREAS the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) on July 22, 2010, approved the Jurupa Valley Reorganization (Attachment "B") to include the incorporation of Jurupa Valley, concurrent detachment from the Riverside County Waste Resources Management District and dissolution of County Service Areas 72 and 73; and

WHEREAS LAFCO requested the Board of Supervisors conduct an election on the subject reorganization; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on September 28, 2010, that:

1. The reorganization shall be subject to confirmation of the voters upon the question thereof at an election that shall be held on March 8, 2011, within the entire territory described in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein. The questions submitted at such election shall be as follows:

"Shall the order adopted on July 22, 2010, by the Local Agency Formation Commission of Riverside County ordering the incorporation of the territory described in the order, including detachment from the Riverside County Waste Resources Management District, dissolution of County Service Areas 72 and 73, subject to the terms and conditions specified in the order designated as LAFCO 2009-32-2 (Resolution No. 12-10) be confirmed"?

"Shall members of the city council in future elections be elected by districts, from districts, or at large"?
