BACKGROUND: A grant for 2010/2011 fiscal year has been awarded by the FDA to promote an informational campaign targeted at restaurant workers for raising awareness about intentional food contamination. Riverside County Environmental Health will be purchasing televisions and installing them in study areas in our lobbies to reach restaurant workers who have come to study for and take required testing. A video of the study material for the exam will be developed and produced for viewing on the office televisions, providing a visual/auditory alternative to our traditional Food Worker Manual. The FDA Food Defense Campaign information will be included in the new video.
