#### **BACKGROUND:**

On March 16, 2010, the Board of Supervisors (Board) approved a Loan Agreement for the use of HOME Investment Partnerships Act Grant Funds ("HOME Funds") with Menifee Vineyards Limited Partnership, a California Limited Partnership ("Owner"), in the amount up to \$1,100,000 ("the HOME Loan Agreement") for the development and construction of a 81-unit rental housing complex for seniors in the City of Menifee ("Project").

Subsequent to that, the Owner applied for Redevelopment Low-and Moderate-Income Housing Funds ("RDA Funds") to the Redevelopment Agency for the County of Riverside ("Agency") and on June 29, 2010 the Agency Board of Directors adopted RDA Resolution 2010-040, Supporting the Application for Low-Income Housing Tax Credits for the Project. The Agency Board of Directors also agreed to finance up to \$3,600,000 in RDA Funds for the development of the Project, subject to the Project meeting all applicable legal requirements, receiving all applicable permits, and negotiation of Agency loan agreement satisfactory to the Board of Directors. The Owner wishes to terminate the HOME Loan Agreement and use the RDA Funds for the Project instead.

Pursuant to Section 38 of the HOME Loan Agreement, in the event that Owner and the County mutually agree to terminate the HOME Loan Agreement, the agreement may be terminated in accordance with 24 CFR 85.44. Upon execution of the termination agreement, the Owner and COUNTY shall be released and discharged from their obligations under the HOME Loan Agreement. No HOME Funds were disbursed.

County Counsel has reviewed and approved as to form the attached Termination Agreement. Staff recommends that the Board approve the attached Termination Agreement.

## TERMINATION AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AND MENIFEE VINEYARDS LIMITED PARTNERSHIP FOR THE USE OF HOME FUNDS

This termination agreement (the "Agreement") is made and entered into on this day of (October, 2010, (the "Effective Date") by and between the County of Riverside ("COUNTY") and Menifee Vineyards Limited Partnership, a California limited partnership ("OWNER").

### WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2010, COUNTY and OWNER entered into a Loan Agreement for the use of Home Investment Partnerships ("HOME") Program Funds (the "HOME Loan Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, under the terms and conditions of the HOME Loan Agreement, COUNTY agreed to lend HOME Funds to OWNER in the amount up to \$1,100,000 for the development and construction of a 81-unit rental housing complex for seniors in the City of Menifee (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 38, Termination, of the HOME Loan Agreement, the OWNER and COUNTY mutually agree to terminate the HOME Loan Agreement; and

WHEREAS, no funds were disbursed to OWNER; and

WHEREAS, OWNER is waiving its right to notice and cure set forth in Section 31 and Section 32 of the HOME Loan Agreement; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the preceding promises and the mutual covenants and agreements hereinafter contained, the parties hereto do hereby agree as follows:

SECTION 1: The HOME Loan Agreement between COUNTY and OWNER is terminated as of the Effective Date of this Agreement.
