**SUBJECT:** DR-1810 Hazard Mitigation Grant Program Local Hazard Mitigation Plan Update

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors authorizes Riverside County Fire Department – Office of Emergency Services (O.E.S.) to accept \$106,564.00 in Hazard Mitigation funding from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA); and direct the Auditor-Controller's Office to make the necessary adjustments on Schedule A.

**BACKGROUND:** The November 2008 California Wildfires and high winds resulted in a major federal disaster declaration, DR-1810. The declared counties include Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, and Santa Barbara making Riverside County eligible for Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) funding.

An approved Local Hazard Mitigation Plan (LHMP) is required by FEMA in order to be eligible to apply for and accept Hazard Mitigation funds that result from disasters. An LHMP is required to be updated every 5 years to meet the requirements of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000. As part of the DR-1810 declaration HMGP funding was made available and FEMA has awarded Riverside County OES a grant to update and complete the LHMP so that Riverside County is in compliance with the FEMA requirement. This grant is a reimbursable grant at 75% of the cost. The in-kind match for the County portion of the grant will be satisfied by existing personnel who will be contributing to the completion of the LHMP.
