### **BACKGROUND**

Riverside County Regional Medical Center (RCRMC) has a total of 241 Hill-Rom hospital beds within the hospital. This agreement is needed to maintain the beds in a safe manner for the patients. Hospital maintenance staff conducts the routine maintenance and service to the beds utilizing parts from Hill-Rom. Conducting the service by hospital staff produces an annual savings of approximately fifteen thousand (\$15,000).
