BACKGROUND (cont'd from page 1):

The Planning Department and County Counsel are in the process of performing a comprehensive review of Ordinance No. 348. During this review, an inconsistency was discovered in the zoning classifications. Not all the zoning classifications included language that would allow non listed uses to be found the same in character and intensity as specifically listed uses. Adding this language would bring uniformity to the County's zoning classifications.

Additionally, it was determined that it would be beneficial to revise the definition of Educational Institutions to include private schools because of the increase in non-public institutions providing instructions to minors and adults in the County.

Under Board Policy A-67, the Board of Supervisors is to consider the costs associated with preparing, processing and implementing an ordinance amendment in deciding whether to adopt an order initiating the amendment. The estimated cost of preparing, processing and implementing this amendment is \$6,000.00.
