



This RFI Log should not be considered to be an addendum but rather answers to Contractor RFI's. If the responses required an addendum, then it is specified accordingly.

RE: Answers to Requests for Information

RFI #1 – Sheet L2, construction note 10 states the existing mulch is to be removed and replaced at the play area. The Contractor's proposal bid breakdown, line 23 calls for 60 CY of engineered wood fiber at play area. Please direct how we are to respond to these 2 notes.

Answer – When the shade system is installed over the play equipment, footings will need to be dug and poured. To do this the existing wood mulch in the play area must be removed then moved back in to the pit. In anticipation of some mulch "loss" we are requiring a bid item of 60 CY of engineered wood fiber play surfacing to "top off" the pit.

RFI #2 – Please clarify note on sheet L3 which states:

"Note: The Contractor shall coordinate with the engineer to provide 120v electrical power and telephone service for the controller(s)" Does this note still apply?

Answer –No. This note reflects existing conditions. There is no need for a new electrical connection, controller, backflow device etc.

RFI #3 - Section 300 - Earthwork

States that clear and grub is to be down to "12" below curb elevations". That seems excessive for this project. Please clarify if that is the intent for this project.

Also, as an alternative to removing the existing turf in a clear and grub operation. Would tilling the turf using a commercial tiller prior to regrading be an acceptable alternative?

Answer – The intent is full removal of the existing "turf" within the project limits. 12" is excessive. The expectation for removal is roughly 4" to fully eliminate existing turf and significant root system. Soil preparation/fine grading is required prior to installation of big roll sod. No, simply tilling existing turf is not acceptable, existing turf must be removed.

RFI #4 -: Section 300 - Earthwork

A) Specifications states to Clear & Grubb down 12" below top of curb (which in this case I would interpret as 12" below sidewalk?). That would mean the removal of approximately 2450 Cubic yards of existing soil. Is that your intent? How will that affect the root system of the existing trees? If that is your intent, that will leave quite a noticeable depression in the ground. We do not see any specs or notes about infilling this, other than the soil amendments.

B) In addition, there is a requirement that the material removed be disposed of at a recycling center. Also we are to provide weight tickets as evidence of disposal of all green waste. For a project this size, that would be cost prohibitive to the County. This material would normally be brought to a landfill designed for this misc. material, and they don't weigh trucks, the charge by the load.

Please clarify.

Answer - A) See answer to question #3 above. B) If not load tickets, then some form of verifiable proof must be provided that the material was disposed of at a facility that separates processes and or is under contract with a green waste recycling center.


