**SUBJECT:** Offer of Reward

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors authorize the allocation of a \$100,000.00 (\$20,000.00 from each Supervisorial District) reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect responsible for the murder of Riverside Police Officer, Ryan Bonaminio.

**BACKGROUND:** In the late hours of Sunday, November 7, 2010, Riverside Police Officer, Ryan Bonaminio, a four-year veteran with the Riverside Police Department, made a traffic stop on a semi-truck suspected of being involved in a hit-and-run accident near the intersection of Highway 60 and Market Street in downtown Riverside. Upon making contact with the driver of the vehicle, a foot pursuit ensued resulting in an altercation with the suspect and ultimate shooting of Officer Bonaminio. Tragically, Officer Bonaminio succumbed to his wounds a short time later at Riverside Community Hospital. In addition to being a proud member of the Riverside Police Department, Officer Bonaminio was a United States Army Veteran of Operation Iraqi Freedom.

It is my hope and I know the hope of our entire Board of Supervisors and all county employees, that this reward will help in the quick apprehension and conviction of the individual responsible for this heinous and cowardly crime.
