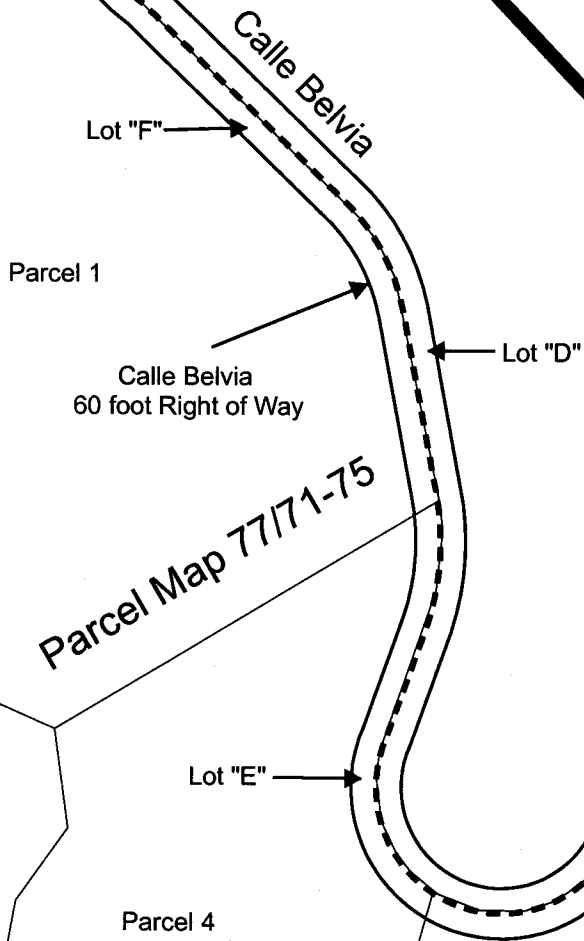

Rainbow Canyon Road

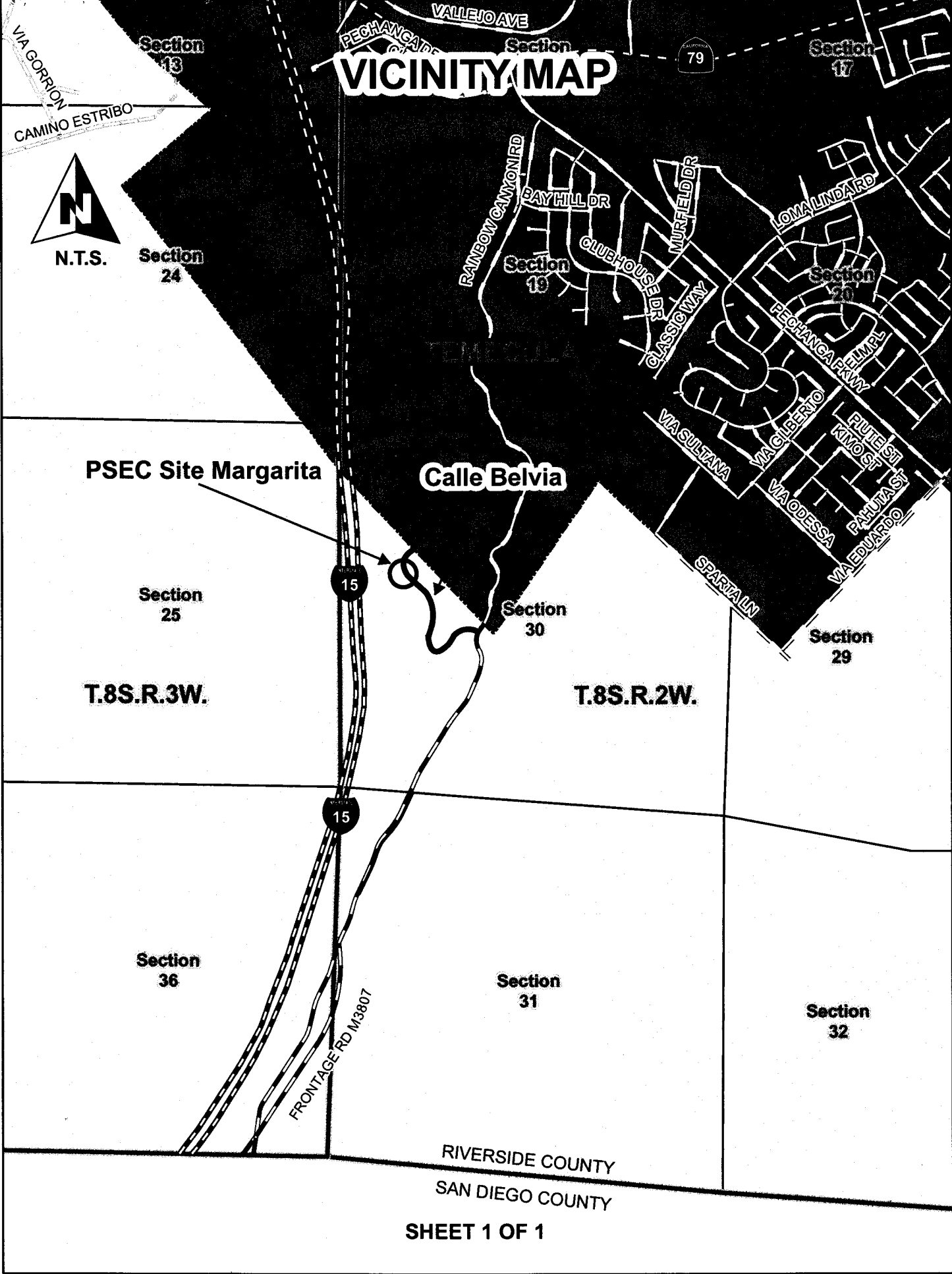
Parcel Map 77/71-75
