**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors approve a reduction of the contract retention for Benards Bros., Inc., of Laguna Hills, California from 10% to 5% per the general conditions of the contract.

BACKGROUND: On February 5, 2008, the Board of Supervisors approved the award of the construction contract to Bernards Bros., Inc., of Laguna Hills, California. Pursuant to the general conditions of the Contract, Economic Development Agency (EDA) is currently retaining 10% of all progress payments to Bernards Bros., Inc. The general conditions of the contract state that after the 50% completion point of the contract work, if satisfactory progress is being made the County has sole discretion to reduce the retention to a minimum of 5% of the contract.
