SUBJECT: : Purchase of Steris Corporation Harmony Dual LED585 package w/single Fiber Optic Flat Panel Monitor Without Seeking Competition for Riverside County Regional Medical Center

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

Approve and authorize the proposed sole source purchase of (2) two Steris Corporation Harmony Dual LED585 packages w/single Fiber Optic Flat Panel Monitors, without seeking competition, in accordance with Ordinance No. 459.4, in the amount of \$275,279.55 to Steris Corporation, pursuant to the Purchasing Agent approving this purchase on behalf of the County.

BACKGROUND: On September 1, 2009 Agenda Number 3.96 the Board of Supervisors approved the purchase of two Steris Corporation Harmon Dual LED585 packages in the amount of \$79,885.27 to enable the architect to receive the required specifications to design the operating room expansion. This Request is for the total package required for the operating rooms to function at completion of the expansion project. Riverside County Regional Medical Center (RCRMC) currently uses Steris lighting systems throughout the hospital; there are fourteen lighting systems within the operating rooms, labor and delivery suite, and emergency department.

PRICE REASONABLENESS:

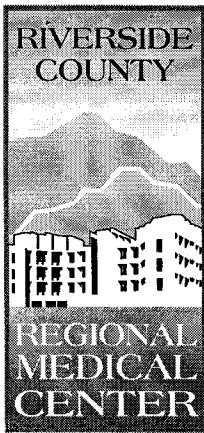


