

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**BACKGROUND**

Global and domestic incidents have increased the demand for ammunition. This demand is perfectly exemplified by the fact that the Sheriff's Department received the final shipment of ammunition in October 2010, for ammunition which was initially ordered in 2008.

County Purchasing released a request for quotes for the Sheriff's ammunition needs (RFQ# PUARC 01158), which closed 10/21/10. Three bids were received. The Sheriff's Department is proposing that the two lowest bidders, Winchester and Federal, be awarded contracts. In addition to meeting the Department's ammunition supply and delivery needs with two vendors, there are performance considerations that would be best met with the ability to purchase from two vendors.

Although each vendor can replicate caliber, vendors of different brands do not duplicate the manufacturing process of each caliber; thus, performance varies between ammunition brands. In FY 2009-10, the Riverside Sheriff's Department conducted an ammunition study of three popular ammunition brands. The result of this study identified Federal as consistently performing toward the maximum scale of the Federal Bureau of Investigation standards, regardless of caliber.

**PRICE REASONABLENESS**

The Sheriff will always buy from the lower cost awarded vendor who can meet the delivery needs and performance specifications of the Department.
