This dedication was prior to any design or construction in the Rice Canyon Area. A few years later, the District designed and constructed an earthen berm to handle the runoff from the hills. In 1983 a study conducted on this area determined that a large portion of this easement was excess to the District's needs. No formal action was completed at that time.

K. Hovnanian Homes now owns a large portion of the property which the easement encompasses in addition to surrounding property. The City of Lake Elsinore has allowed development in a portion of the easement area pursuant to the 1983 study. In addition, a condition of development was placed on a portion of the developer's property which requires a conservation easement that will keep it in its natural state. In the interest of facilitating the establishment of a conservation easement and the determination that a portion of the District-owned easement interest is excess real property and not required for the District's needs, it is recommended that the easement referred to as RCFC Parcel No. 3050-1B, as shown on Exhibits "A" and "B", is declared surplus to the District's needs and be summarily vacated.
