I am writing from a background including leadership in the attempt to form Canyon County out of the northwest corner of L.A. Co. in 1970-1976, leading the incorporation of the City of Santa Clarita in 1987, service for three terms as councilmember and rotating into Mayor's office twice, as well as being happily retired from politics since 1998.

Some years ago about sixteen of the counties of northern California voted (in popular elections) that they would prefer being a separate state. I don't think it makes much sense to group L.A. with that lot, but a third state of western Calif. counties might work. As I recall, the northern counties had the referendums put on the county ballots by the boards of supervisors. Sacramento County waffled, they would join Northern California if the state were split.

To me the major problem is that the size of the state is out of control. L.A. Co. alone is larger than two-thirds of the nations of the world in population, and could make a state with at least seven counties.

I would suggest a convention to discuss the issue.
