18 Supervisors at 4080 Lemon Street, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, Riverside, California; and

19 **WHEREAS**, notice of said public hearing was duly published as required by Resolution No. 2011-  
20 160 and Section 22626(a) of the Streets and Highways code; and

21 **WHEREAS**, at the time and place of said public hearing, as set forth in Resolution No. 2011-160, the  
22 Board of Supervisors held the public hearing and afforded all interested persons an opportunity to testify  
23 and be heard, and considered all oral statements and all written protests or communications made or filed  
24 by any interested persons and at the conclusion of said hearing determined that a majority protest had not  
25 been received; and

26 **WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors may proceed, pursuant to Section 22631 of the Streets and  
27 Highways Code, to adopt a resolution confirming the diagram and assessment, either as originally


