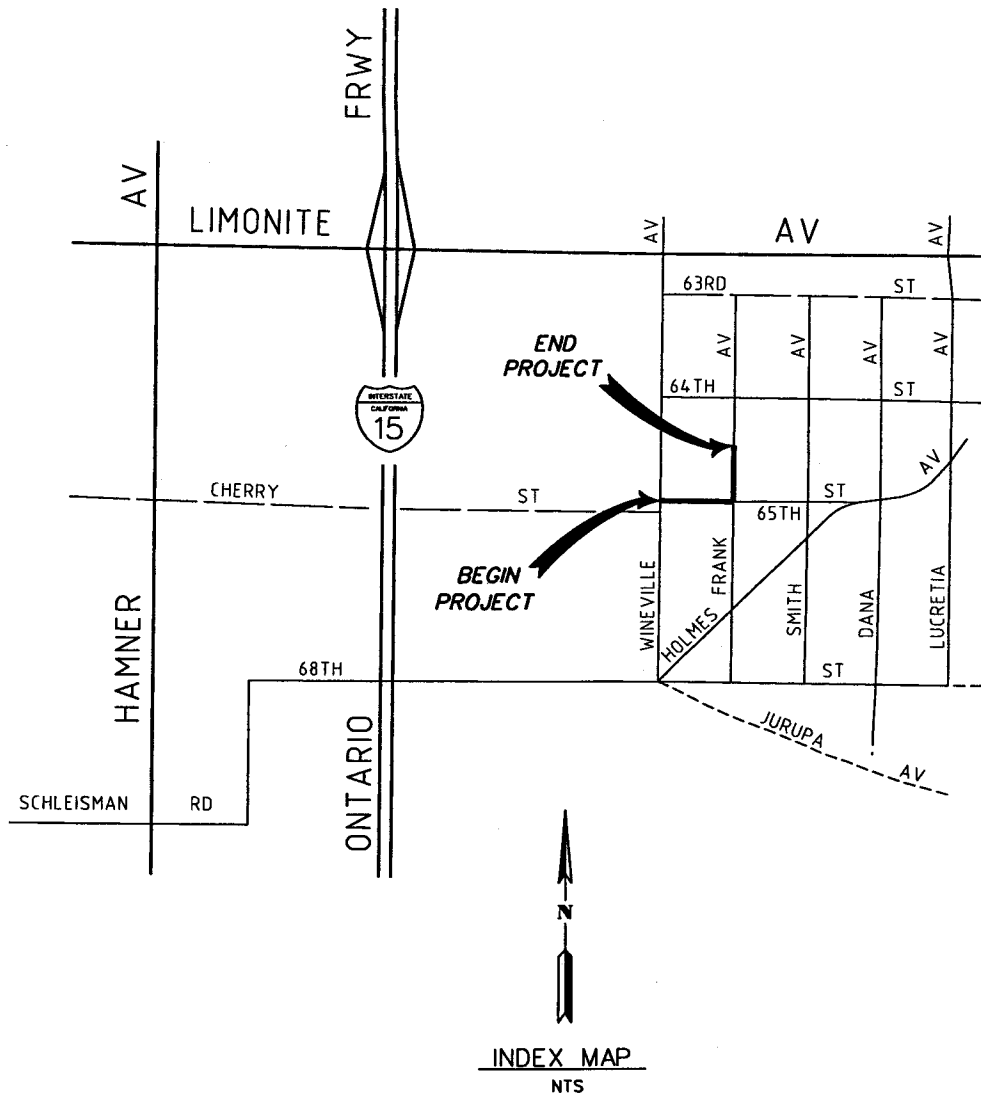

DAY CREEK - FRANK AVENUE STORM DRAIN IS LOCATED WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED MIRA LOMA COMMUNITY OF RIVERSIDE COUNTY AND CONSISTS OF APPROXIMATELY 1,100 LINEAL FEET OF 18-INCH DIAMETER REINFORCED CONCRETE PIPE. THIS PROJECT IS AN UNDERGROUND SYSTEM DESIGNED TO DRAIN THE EXISTING SUMP AREA LOCATED ON THE WEST SIDE OF FRANK AVENUE BETWEEN 64TH AND 65TH STREETS.
