BACKGROUND: continued

To prevent damage to the communities and to prevent further damage to the facilities, the District hired several contractors to assist with shoring up the levees and other emergency work as needed. As per County policy, the District is requesting Board approval for authorization to pay for these necessary costs. The projects and contractors, with estimates of costs are listed below:
