BACKGROUND:

The Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) provides services throughout the Coachella Valley. Volunteers advocate for the safety and well being of children who have been removed from their homes due to parental abuse or neglect.

The Indio Performing Arts Center provides programs and activities for low income seniors and teens.

Martha's Village & Kitchen Clinic provides medical treatment to low income and homeless individuals.
