BACKGROUND/APPOINTEE INFORMATION:

The Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance No. 784 that governs the First 5 Commission. The current language provides that if a Commissioner misses a disignated number of meetings, a vacancy of that position automatically occurs. However, this vacancy can be waived by majority approval of the Board of Supervisors. In this instance, Commission Cox missed four meetings due to circumstances beyond her control.

Commissioners Cox anticipates being able to attend regularly going forward and has expressed an interest in remaining on the Commission. First 5 staff are recommending that the Board of Supervisors exercise the waiver provision.
