BACKGROUND (cont'd from page 1):

On November 9, 2010, the Board of Supervisors ordered the initiation of Ordinance No. 787.6 to adopt the 2010 California Fire Code. The 2010 California Fire Code took effect on January 1, 2010, and updates the 2007 California Fire Code to include requirements that increase fire resistance in buildings and homes.

Ordinance No. 787.6 adopts the 2010 California Fire Code with amendments pursuant to Health and Safety Code Sections 17958 and 17958.7, which allows the County to require more restrictive development standards based on findings related to local climatic, topographical and geological conditions. These findings are made in Section 1 of Ordinance No. 787.6 and in Attachment A prepared by the Fire Department, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

Ordinance No. 787.6 cites specific sections in the 2010 California Fire Code that are being amended by the ordinance. Where Ordinance No. 787.6 amends a specific section by deleting it entirely and replacing it with new language, only the specific section referenced in Ordinance No. 787.6 is being amended. Those sections not specifically referenced remain in effect.

Ordinance No. 787.6 is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3) as it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment. The proposed ordinance amendment merely adopts the 2010 California Fire Code, as amended. Any actual project proposed by property owners will have to undergo its own CEQA analysis.
