BACKGROUND:

By Minute Order dated December 14, 2010 (agenda item 3.56), the Board authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the pavement resurfacing of Van Buren Boulevard from Barton Street to include the frontage of the Riverside National Cemetery and associated improvements, in the Orangecrest area. Additionally, the specifications were approved by the Board within this agenda item.

During the advertisement period, one addendum was issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the specifications and special provisions. Bidders are required to acknowledge and to take into account all issued addenda on their Contractor's Proposal to be considered for award. The addendum was issued to clarify and modify the approved contract documents. The addendum is attached as Addendum No. 1.

Bids for the project were opened in the office of the Director of Transportation at 2:00 PM, Wednesday, January 5, 2011. Eight bids were received. The basis for the selection of a contractor is the lowest responsive and responsible bid for all schedules of work. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by All American Asphalt in the amount of \$2,428,668 which is \$837,212 (25.64%) below the Engineer's Estimate.

Roadway resurfacing is a preventive measure which will mitigate the current deteriorated road conditions. The road improvements include cold plane and removing the existing pavement, placing new asphalt concrete pavement, constructing segments of asphalt concrete dike, and overside drains. Additional improvements include installation of detector loops, striping, pavement markings, and relocation of roadway signs; adjustment of manholes and water valves to grade, and other associated work.

This project includes the Base Bid for roadway improvements and an Alternate bid schedule 1 to adjust sewer manhole covers to grade, which are owned by the Western Municipal Water District. The District has approved the award of the alternate bid schedule as bid by the apparent low bidder, and the costs for the work will be funded by the District.

The contractor is qualified and has executed the contract. The contractor has also provided performance bond, payment bond and insurance documents.

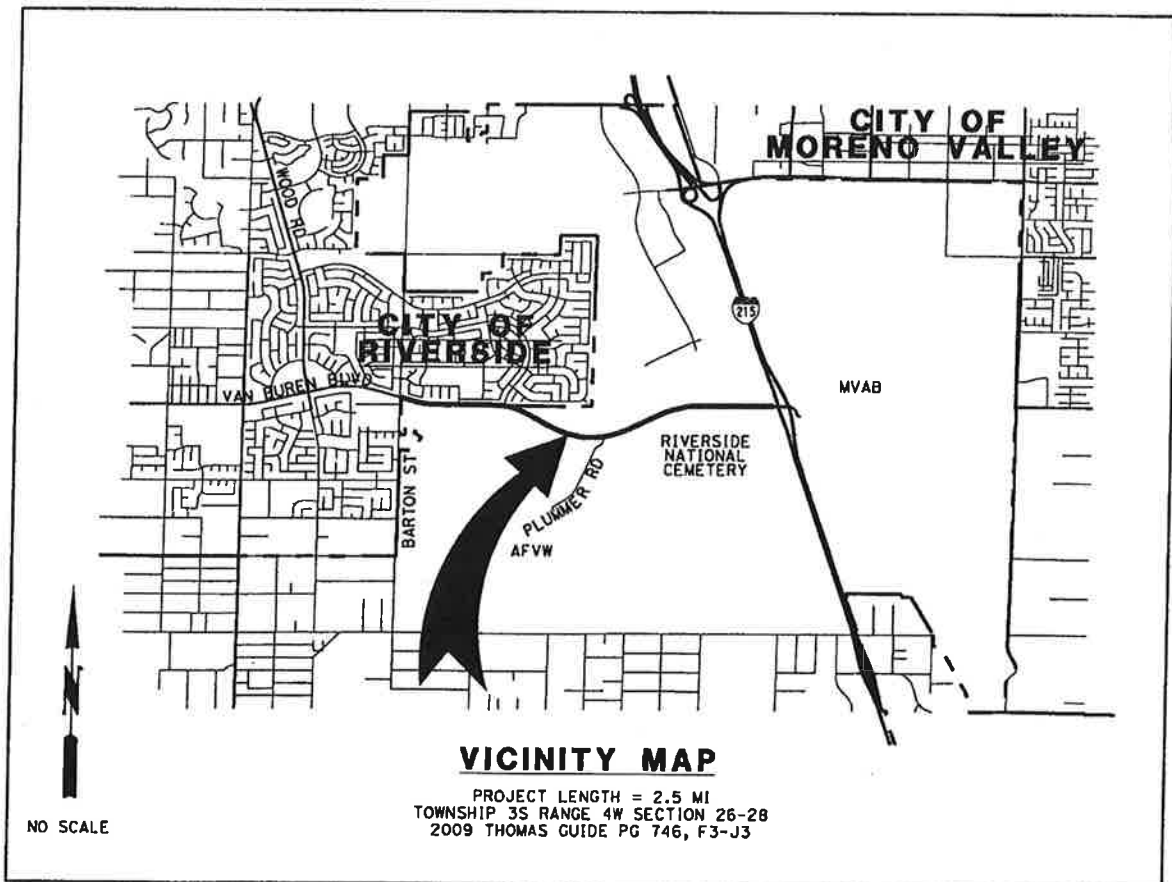
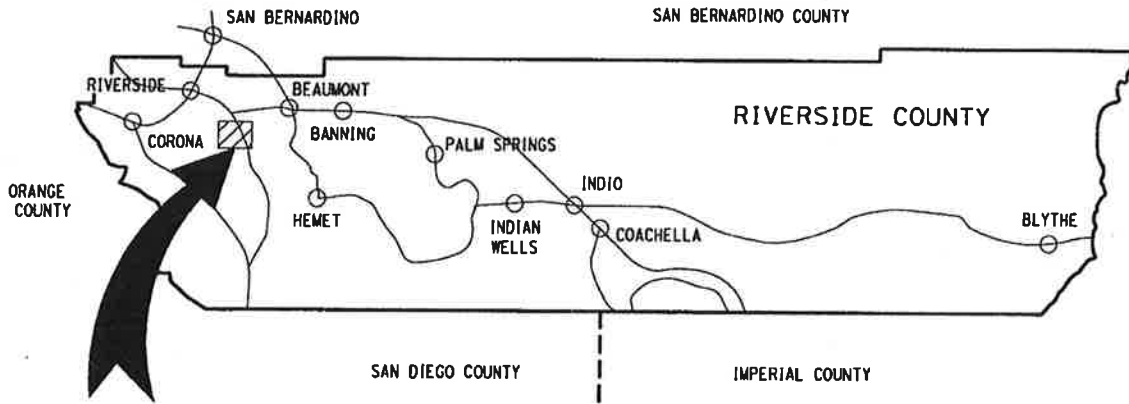

This Addendum is issued pursuant to the instructions to Bidders, Item No. 8, of the Contract Document for the referenced project. This Addendum is issued as a supplement to the plans, specifications and special provisions for the referenced project. Any revisions to the plans and specifications shall become a part of the Contract Documents, and each bidder shall acknowledge receipt thereof on the Contractor's Proposal. Bidders are directed to sign this addendum as acknowledged, and attach the signed addendum to the contractor's submitted proposal.

MODIFICATIONS / CLARIFICATIONS TO SPECIAL PROVISIONS

Item 1: Revised Proposal. Refer to "Proposal" page B3. Proposal (page B3) is deleted and replaced with revised "Proposal" attached herewith as **Attachment "A"**. The following additional revisions have been made to the Proposal bid schedules:

- a. Estimated Quantities are revised from the following bid items:

- Item 6, "COLD PLANE ASPHALT CONCRETE PAVEMENT (.20' MAXIMUM)"
 - Item 9, "ROADWAY EXCAVATION"
 - Item 12, "CLASS 2 AGGREGATE BASE"
 - Item 16, "HOT MIX ASPHALT"
- b. The following bid items have been added:
- Item 21, "RUMBLE STRIP"
 - Item 22, "MINOR CONCRETE (CURB RAMP)"
 - Item 23, "CONSTRUCTION PROJECT FUNDING IDENTIFICATION SIGNS"
 - Item 24, "OBTAIN ENCROACHMENT PERMIT"
 - Item 25, "ADJUST MANHOLE TO GRADE [SEWER]", formerly Item 21

Item 2: **Liquidated Damages.** Refer to section entitled "LIQUIDATED DAMAGES" on page 49. The following paragraph is added after the third paragraph: —

"The Contractor shall have 5 calendar days to complete all pavement reconstruction, except the final pavement lift, on Van Buren Blvd, with additional liquidated damages of \$10,000.00 per day."

Item 3: **Order of Work.** Refer to section entitled "ORDER OF WORK" page 50. The following two paragraphs are added after the last paragraph on page 50:

"Attention is directed to "Closure Requirements and Conditions" of these Special Provisions regarding work schedule for pavement reconstruction on Van Buren Blvd. The Contractor is permitted complete lane closure, for the eastbound #2 lane, the lane to be reconstructed, for five (5) consecutive working days, Monday through Friday, to complete this work. The eastbound #1 lane shall be open to traffic at all times during the closure. Resurfacing of the eastbound #1 lane, adjacent to the closure, is not permitted during the closure."

"Attention is directed to "Grind Asphalt Concrete in Place" of these Special Provisions regarding work procedure. At no time will traffic be allowed on pulverized material. Each working night, the contractor will pulverize, grade, compact to 95%, and place the first lift of asphalt. No vertical drops are

permitted between lanes during non-working hours. Transitions between lifts shall not exceed 2% or as approved by Engineer during non-working hours.”

Item 4: Closure Requirements and Conditions. Refer to section entitled “CLOSURE REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS” pages 53 through 54. The following paragraph is added:

“The Contractor is permitted complete lane closure, for the eastbound #2 lane, the lane to be reconstructed, for five (5) consecutive working days, Monday through Friday, to complete this work. The eastbound #1 lane shall be open to traffic at all times during the closure. Resurfacing of the eastbound #1 lane, adjacent to the closure, is not permitted during the closure. “

Item 5: Grind Asphalt Concrete in Place. Refer to section entitled “GRINDING ASPHALT CONCRETE IN PLACE” page 71. The following paragraph is added:

“At no time will traffic be allowed on pulverized material. Each working night, the contractor will pulverize, grade, compact to 95%, and place the first lift of asphalt. No vertical drops are permitted between lanes during non-working hours. Transitions between lifts shall not exceed 2% or as approved by Engineer during non-working hours.”

Item 6: Traffic Control System. Refer to section entitled “TRAFFIC CONTROL SYSTEM/ PUBLIC CONVENIENCE/ PUBLIC SAFETY” pages 51 through 52. The following paragraph is added:

“Traffic Control Plans are to be submitted to City of Riverside to obtain an encroachment permit. All fees for obtaining Encroachment permit will be paid through FA.”

Item 7: Rumble Strip. The following Special Provisions are added hereby:

RUMBLE STRIP:

Construction of rumble strips by ground-in indentations shall be per Caltrans Plan No. A40B, modified. Length, width, depth and spacing shall be per standard, modified with placement centered on centerline of road. Indentation shall be completed prior to striping. Centerline striping and RPM placement shall be per Riverside County standards.

Refer to plans for station numbering limits.

Select the method and equipment for constructing ground-in indentations.

Ground-in equipment must be equipped with a sighting device enabling the operator to maintain the rumble strip alignment.

Indentations must not vary from the specified dimensions by more than 1/16 inch in depth or more than 10 percent in length and width.

The Engineer orders grinding or removal and replacement of noncompliant rumble strips to bring them within specified tolerances. Ground surface areas must be neat and uniform in appearance.

The grinding equipment must be equipped with a vacuum attachment to remove residue.

Dispose of removed material under Section 7-1.13 of the Standard Specifications, "Disposal of Material Outside the Highway Right of Way", and "Disposal of Excess Excavation or Materials" of these special provisions.

The contract unit bid price paid per linear foot for Rumble Strips. Bid Item shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals, for doing all the work involved and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.

Item 8: Curb Ramp. The following Special Provisions are added hereby:

MINOR CONCRETE (CURB RAMP):

Concrete curb ramps shall be constructed in accordance with the County of Riverside Road Improvement Standards and Specifications and in conformance with Sections 51, 73 and 90 of the Standard Specifications.

Class 3 concrete shall be used for curb and gutter, and curb ramp, driveway, and sidewalk.

Construction of concrete improvements shall include all removal and restoration of the affected irrigation and landscaping, and related work, to return the area adjacent to the new improvements to its original condition and to conform the area to the new improvements.

The area behind and along the concrete improvements shall be filled and compacted with native or select material and graded to match and provide a smooth transition from the edge of the new improvements, to the satisfaction of the Engineer.

Preparation of subgrade for the concrete structures shall be done in conformance with the requirements of Section 73-1.02 of the Standard Specifications. Unless

otherwise specified, all curbs and gutters will be backfilled as shown on the plans.

Excess material resulting from the excavation of the subgrade shall be disposed of as elsewhere provided in these Special Specifications.

The Contractor is responsible for meeting requirements of all American with Disability Act (ADA).

Construction of curb ramps shall include, but not be limited to, the following:

- 1) Removal and disposal of existing sidewalk, curb, and/or curb and gutter, and existing soil and aggregate as required;
- 2) Establishing grades, and assuring that all grades are met;
- 3) Performing all grading and compaction – including all required aggregate import, as directed by the Engineer and in accordance with County Standard 403;
- 4) Construction of new curb ramp;
- 5) All scoring/grooving and required saw cutting;
- 6) Repair of existing asphalt and PCC surfacing;
- 7) Installing 1/2" wide expansion joints;
- 8) All landscaping, and related work, to return the area adjacent to the curb ramps to its original condition and to conform the area to the new improvements;

At a minimum, the area from the BCR to ECR shall meet all required ADA standards. Therefore, to conform to existing conditions and/or to achieve the required four-foot level area (maximum of 2.0% crossfall) at the top portion of the curb ramp, it may be necessary to extend the work beyond the BCR/ECR in certain instances.

The contract unit bid prices paid per each for Minor Concrete (Curb Ramp) shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, equipment, including the excavation or placing of suitable fill to prepare the sub-grade, furnishing and placing expansion joint material, materials and tools, and incidentals, and for doing all the work involved in the construction and complete in place as shown on the plans, or as herein specified, or as directed by the Engineer.

Item 9: **Construction Project Funding Identification Sign.** Refer to section "CONSTRUCTION PROJECT FUNDING IDENTIFICATION SIGN" on page 58. The entire provision is deleted and replaced with the following:

"The Contractor shall furnish and install **two (2)** Construction Project Funding Identification Signs (4' X 8'); the signs shall be installed at locations to be determined by the Engineer, within or near the project limits, in accordance with the relevant requirements of Section 56-2 of the Standard Specifications and the

appropriate details of Standard Plans RS1 through RS4 for two post installation of signs, and as directed by the Engineer.

A reference exhibit displaying the text and colors of the sign will be provided to the Contractor prior to construction. The Contractor shall submit a copy of the final sign design for approval by the resident Engineer prior to fabrication.

The Contractor shall submit to the Engineer the final sign design in the form of an editable picture file in .eps format – Encapsulated PostScript file.

At the completion of the project, the signs will become property of the County. When directed by the Engineer, the Contractor shall remove all hardware from the signs. Posts and hardware shall become the property of the Contractor. The Contractor shall deliver and off-load the signs to the address listed below or as directed by the Engineer:

Method of Payment

The contract price paid **per each** for Construction Project Funding Identification Sign shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, incidentals and for doing all the work including sign installation, transportation, maintenance, removal, delivery, excavation and backfill as specified in the Standard Specification and these Special Provisions and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.”

Item 10: The following drawing is included as **Attachment “B”**, which is made a part hereof:

- CONSTRUCTION PROJECT FUNDING IDENTIFICATION SIGN, Exhibit

Item 11: **Obstructions.** Refer to section entitled “OBSTRUCTIONS” pages 58 through 62. The following two paragraphs are added to this section and made part hereof:

“Attention is directed to the existence of utility facilities that cross and are within the planned road reconstruction area (Construction note 8). The 24” water pipeline that is shown on the plans is approximately 48” below grade, based on record maps provided by the owner. The Contractor shall pothole this pipeline at

a minimum of 3 random locations, as directed by the engineer, to verify its depth.

Additionally, the Contractor is additionally directed to pothole all utility facilities that exist within the roadway widening area, as indicated by DigAlert utility markings, prior to performing any excavation, as directed by the Engineer. If the existing utility is shallow, as determined by the Engineer, the Contractor shall contact the owner of the utility and arrange for a meeting with the utility owner and the Engineer to determine the course of action so as to protect the utility in-place. All decisions and direction of the Engineer shall be considered as final. All work near and affecting shallow utility facilities within the roadway widening areas shall be performed only after providing the utility owner with at least 48 hours advance notice of such work. Full compensation for compliance with the potholing and coordination requirements of this Addendum item shall be considered as included in the various items of work, and no additional compensation will be allowed therefore."

Item 12: **Water Pollution Control (Santa Ana River Basin-Risk Level 1).** Refer to section entitled "WATER POLLUTION CONTROL (SANTA ANA RIVER BASIN-RISK LEVEL 1)" pages 62 through 68. Delete the fifth paragraph on page 64 and replace with the following paragraph:

"Within **ten (10)** working days after the award of the contract, the Contractor shall submit two (2) copies of the SWPPP/MP to the Engineer for review and approval. The Contractor shall allow **five (5)** working days for the Engineer to review the SWPPP/MP. If revisions are required as determined by the Engineer, the Contractor shall revise and resubmit the SWPPP/MP within three (3) working days of receipt of the Engineer's comments and shall allow **five (5)** working days for the Engineer to review the revisions. The Contractor shall submit four (4) copies of the approved SWPPP/MP to the Engineer prior to notice to proceed. The Contractor must have an approved SWPPP/MP prior to the notice to proceed. The Engineer may provide a letter of conditional approval of the Contractor's SWPPP/MP while minor revisions are made and may allow the Contractor to begin only those certain construction activities identified in the letter of conditional approval. In no case will the conditional approval extend beyond twenty-one (21) calendar days. The Engineer may suspend construction operations until the Contractor submits a revised SWPPP/MP that is reviewed and approved by the Engineer."

Item 13: **Portable Changeable Message Signs.** Refer to section entitled "PORTABLE CHANGEABLE MESSAGE SIGNS" pages 55 through 57. Delete the last two paragraphs and replace with the following paragraph:

"Full compensation for portable changeable message signs, including furnishing, placing, operating, modifying messages, maintaining, transporting from location to location, removing, and repairing or replacing defective or damaged portable

changeable message signs **shall be** included in the contract **lump sum** price paid for **Traffic Control System** and no separate payment will be made therefor.”

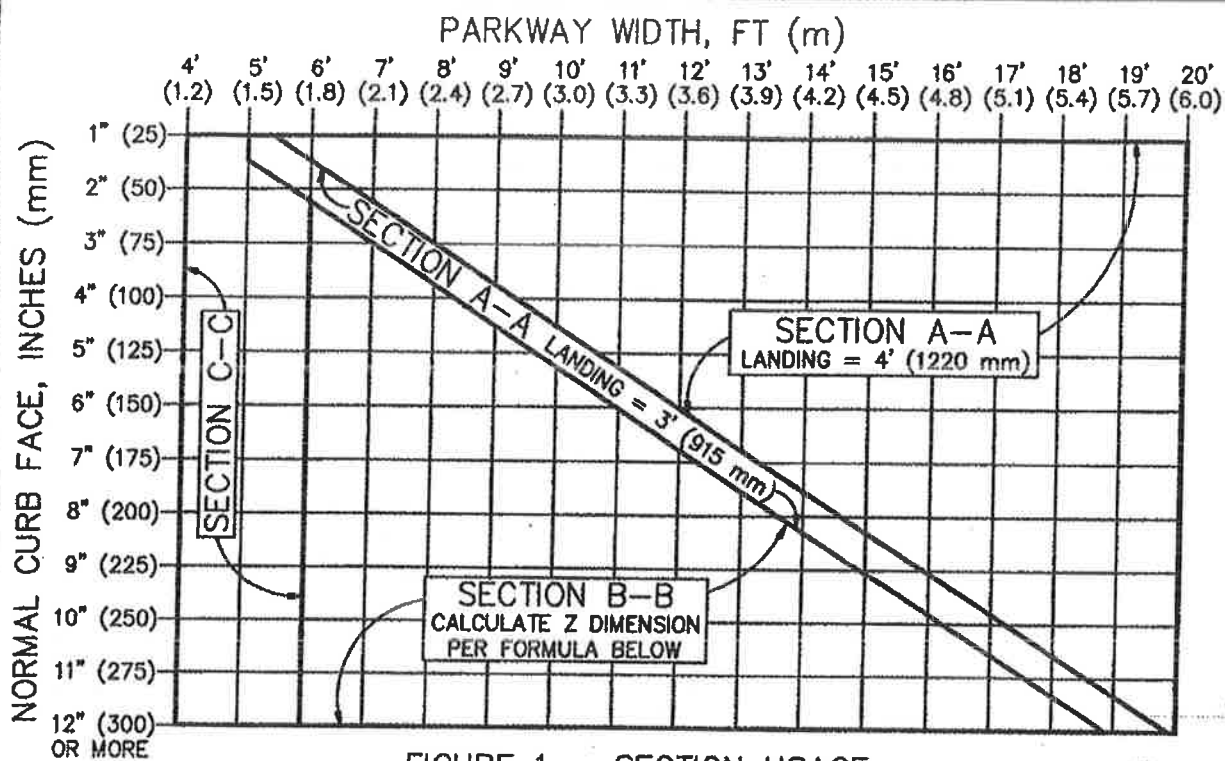


FIGURE 1 - SECTION USAGE

ESCROW AGREEMENT FOR
SECURITY DEPOSITS IN LIEU OF RETENTION

THIS ESCROW AGREEMENT FOR SECURITY DEPOSITS IN LIEU OF RETENTION (hereinafter called the "Agreement") is made and entered into on this 8th day of February, 2011, by and between **County of Riverside**, whose address is 3525 14th Street, Riverside, CA 92501 (hereinafter called "Owner"), **All American Asphalt**, whose address is P.O. Box 2229, Corona, CA 92878 (hereinafter called "Contractor"), and **Community Bank**, a California banking corporation, whose address is 505 E. Colorado Boulevard, Pasadena, California 91101 (hereinafter called "Escrow Agent").

WHEREAS, the parties desire to establish an escrow account with Escrow Agent (the "Escrow Account") pursuant to the provisions of Section 22300 of the California Public Contract Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, for the consideration hereinafter set forth, the Owner, Contractor, and Escrow Agent agree as follows:

1. Pursuant to Section 22300 of the Public Contract Code of the State of California, the Contractor has the option to deposit securities with Escrow Agent as a substitute for retention earnings required to be withheld by the Owner pursuant to the Construction Contract entered into between the Owner and the Contractor, for **Van Buren Blvd. Resurfacing Project from Barton St. to Riverside National Cemetery** in the amount of **\$2,428,668.00** (hereinafter referred to as the "Contract"). Alternatively, **on written request of the Contractor, the Owner shall make payments of the retention earnings directly to the Escrow Agent.** When the Contractor deposits the securities as a substitute for Contract earnings, the Escrow Agent shall notify the Owner within ten (10) days of the deposit. The market value of the securities at the time of the substitution shall be at least equal to the cash amount then required to be withheld as retention under the terms of the Contract between the Owner and the Contractor. Securities shall be held in the name of **County of Riverside**, and shall designate the Contractor as the beneficial owner.
2. The Owner shall make progress payments to the Contractor for those funds which otherwise would be withheld from progress payments pursuant to the Contract provisions, provided that the Escrow Agent holds securities in the form and amount specified above.
3. When the Owner makes payment of the retentions earned directly to the Escrow Agent, the Escrow Agent shall hold them for the benefit of the Contractor until the time that the escrow created under this Agreement is terminated. The Contractor may direct the investment of the payments into securities. All terms and conditions of this Agreement and the rights and responsibilities of the parties shall be equally applicable and binding when the Owner pays the Escrow Agent directly.
4. The Contractor shall be responsible for paying all fees for the expenses incurred by the Escrow Agent in administering the Escrow Account and all expenses of the Owner. These expenses and payment terms shall be determined by the Owner, the Contractor and the Escrow Agent.

5. The interest earned on the securities or the money market accounts held in escrow and all interest earned on that interest shall be for the sole account of the Contractor and shall be subject to withdrawal by the Contractor at any time and from time to time without notice to the Owner.
6. The Contractor shall have the right to withdraw all or any part of the principal in the Escrow Account only by written notice to the Escrow Agent accompanied by written authorization from the Owner to the Escrow Agent that the Owner consents to the withdrawal of the amount sought to be withdrawn by the Contractor.
7. The Owner shall have a right to draw upon the securities in the event of default by the Contractor. Upon seven days' written notice to the Escrow Agent from the Owner of the default, the Escrow Agent shall immediately convert the securities to cash and shall distribute the cash as instructed by the Owner.
8. Upon receipt of written notification from the Owner certifying that the Contract is final and complete, and that the Contractor has complied with all requirements and procedures applicable to the Contract, the Escrow Agent shall release to the Contractor all securities and interest on deposit less escrow fees and charges of the Escrow Account. The escrow shall be closed immediately upon disbursement of all moneys and securities on deposit and payments of fees and charges.
9. The Escrow Agent shall rely on the written notifications from the Owner and the Contractor pursuant to Sections 5 to 8, inclusive, of this Agreement and the Owner and the Contractor shall hold the Escrow Agent harmless from the Escrow Agent's release and disbursement of the securities and interest as set forth above.

W I T N E S S E T H

RECITALS:

1. Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, **Van Buren Boulevard Resurfacing Project, from Barton Street to Riverside National Cemetery, Project No. C1-0550**, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

AGREEMENT:

IT IS AGREED BY THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

1. Contract Documents. The entire contract consists of the following: (a) The Agreement. (b) The Notice Inviting Bids. (c) The Instruction to Bidders. (d) The Contractor's Proposal. (e) The Bid Bond. (f) The Payment Bond. (g) The Performance Bond. (h) The General Conditions. (i) The Special Provisions. (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of May 2006 as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents. (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions. (l) The Plans. (m) Addenda **(1)**. (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Work. (o) Any Change Orders issued. (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. MODIFICATIONS / CLARIFICATIONS TO SPECIAL PROVISIONS

Item 1: Revised Proposal. Refer to "Proposal" page B3. Proposal (page B3) is deleted and replaced with revised "Proposal" attached herewith as **Attachment "A"**. The following additional revisions have been made to the Proposal bid schedules:

Item 2: **Liquidated Damages.** Refer to section entitled "LIQUIDATED DAMAGES" on page 49. The following paragraph is added after the third paragraph:

"The Contractor shall have 5 calendar days to complete all pavement reconstruction, except the final pavement lift, on Van Buren Blvd, with additional liquidated damages of \$10,000.00 per day."

Item 3: **Order of Work.** Refer to section entitled "ORDER OF WORK" page 50. The following two paragraphs are added after the last paragraph on page 50:

"Attention is directed to "Closure Requirements and Conditions" of these Special Provisions regarding work schedule for pavement reconstruction on Van Buren Blvd. The Contractor is permitted complete lane closure, for the eastbound #2 lane, the lane to be reconstructed, for five (5) consecutive working days, Monday through Friday, to complete this work. The eastbound #1 lane shall be open to traffic at all times during the closure. Resurfacing of the eastbound #1 lane, adjacent to the closure, is not permitted during the closure."

"Attention is directed to "Grind Asphalt Concrete in Place" of these Special Provisions regarding work procedure. At no time will traffic be allowed on pulverized material. Each working night, the contractor will pulverize, grade, compact to 95%, and place the first lift of asphalt. No vertical drops are

permitted between lanes during non-working hours. Transitions between lifts shall not exceed 2% or as approved by Engineer during non-working hours."

Item 4: Closure Requirements and Conditions. Refer to section entitled "CLOSURE REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS" pages 53 through 54. The following paragraph is added:

"The Contractor is permitted complete lane closure, for the eastbound #2 lane, the lane to be reconstructed, for five (5) consecutive working days, Monday through Friday, to complete this work. The eastbound #1 lane shall be open to traffic at all times during the closure. Resurfacing of the eastbound #1 lane, adjacent to the closure, is not permitted during the closure. "

Item 5: Grind Asphalt Concrete in Place. Refer to section entitled "GRINDING ASPHALT CONCRETE IN PLACE" page 71. The following paragraph is added:

"At no time will traffic be allowed on pulverized material. Each working night, the contractor will pulverize, grade, compact to 95%, and place the first lift of asphalt. No vertical drops are permitted between lanes during non-working hours. Transitions between lifts shall not exceed 2% or as approved by Engineer during non-working hours."

Item 6: Traffic Control System. Refer to section entitled "TRAFFIC CONTROL SYSTEM/ PUBLIC CONVENIENCE/ PUBLIC SAFETY" pages 51 through 52. The following paragraph is added:

"Traffic Control Plans are to be submitted to City of Riverside to obtain an encroachment permit. All fees for obtaining Encroachment permit will be paid through FA."

Item 7: Rumble Strip. The following Special Provisions are added hereby:

RUMBLE STRIP:

Construction of rumble strips by ground-in indentations shall be per Caltrans Plan No. A40B, modified. Length, width, depth and spacing shall be per standard, modified with placement centered on centerline of road. Indentation shall be completed prior to striping. Centerline striping and RPM placement shall be per Riverside County standards.

Refer to plans for station numbering limits.

Select the method and equipment for constructing ground-in indentations.

Ground-in equipment must be equipped with a sighting device enabling the operator to maintain the rumble strip alignment.

Indentations must not vary from the specified dimensions by more than 1/16 inch in depth or more than 10 percent in length and width.

The Engineer orders grinding or removal and replacement of noncompliant rumble strips to bring them within specified tolerances. Ground surface areas must be neat and uniform in appearance.

The grinding equipment must be equipped with a vacuum attachment to remove residue.

Dispose of removed material under Section 7-1.13 of the Standard Specifications, "Disposal of Material Outside the Highway Right of Way", and "Disposal of Excess Excavation or Materials" of these special provisions.

The contract unit bid price paid per linear foot for Rumble Strips. Bid Item shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals, for doing all the work involved and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.

Item 8: Curb Ramp. The following Special Provisions are added hereby:

MINOR CONCRETE (CURB RAMP):

Concrete curb ramps shall be constructed in accordance with the County of Riverside Road Improvement Standards and Specifications and in conformance with Sections 51, 73 and 90 of the Standard Specifications.

Class 3 concrete shall be used for curb and gutter, and curb ramp, driveway, and sidewalk.

Construction of concrete improvements shall include all removal and restoration of the affected irrigation and landscaping, and related work, to return the area adjacent to the new improvements to its original condition and to conform the area to the new improvements.

The area behind and along the concrete improvements shall be filled and compacted with native or select material and graded to match and provide a smooth transition from the edge of the new improvements, to the satisfaction of the Engineer.

Preparation of subgrade for the concrete structures shall be done in conformance with the requirements of Section 73-1.02 of the Standard Specifications. Unless

otherwise specified, all curbs and gutters will be backfilled as shown on the plans.

Excess material resulting from the excavation of the subgrade shall be disposed of as elsewhere provided in these Special Specifications.

The Contractor is responsible for meeting requirements of all American with Disability Act (ADA).

Construction of curb ramps shall include, but not be limited to, the following:

- 1) Removal and disposal of existing sidewalk, curb, and/or curb and gutter, and existing soil and aggregate as required;
- 2) Establishing grades, and assuring that all grades are met;
- 3) Performing all grading and compaction – including all required aggregate import, as directed by the Engineer and in accordance with County Standard 403;
- 4) Construction of new curb ramp;
- 5) All scoring/grooving and required saw cutting;
- 6) Repair of existing asphalt and PCC surfacing;
- 7) Installing 1/2" wide expansion joints;
- 8) All landscaping, and related work, to return the area adjacent to the curb ramps to its original condition and to conform the area to the new improvements;

At a minimum, the area from the BCR to ECR shall meet all required ADA standards. Therefore, to conform to existing conditions and/or to achieve the required four-foot level area (maximum of 2.0% crossfall) at the top portion of the curb ramp, it may be necessary to extend the work beyond the BCR/ECR in certain instances.

The contract unit bid prices paid per each for Minor Concrete (Curb Ramp) shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, equipment, including the excavation or placing of suitable fill to prepare the sub-grade, furnishing and placing expansion joint material, materials and tools, and incidentals, and for doing all the work involved in the construction and complete in place as shown on the plans, or as herein specified, or as directed by the Engineer.

Item 9: **Construction Project Funding Identification Sign.** Refer to section "CONSTRUCTION PROJECT FUNDING IDENTIFICATION SIGN" on page 58. The entire provision is deleted and replaced with the following:

"The Contractor shall furnish and install **two (2)** Construction Project Funding Identification Signs (4' X 8'); the signs shall be installed at locations to be determined by the Engineer, within or near the project limits, in accordance with the relevant requirements of Section 56-2 of the Standard Specifications and the

appropriate details of Standard Plans RS1 through RS4 for two post installation of signs, and as directed by the Engineer.

A reference exhibit displaying the text and colors of the sign will be provided to the Contractor prior to construction. The Contractor shall submit a copy of the final sign design for approval by the resident Engineer prior to fabrication.

Item 11: **Obstructions.** Refer to section entitled “OBSTRUCTIONS” pages 58 through 62. The following two paragraphs are added to this section and made part hereof:

“Attention is directed to the existence of utility facilities that cross and are within the planned road reconstruction area (Construction note 8). The 24” water pipeline that is shown on the plans is approximately 48” below grade, based on record maps provided by the owner. The Contractor shall pothole this pipeline at

a minimum of 3 random locations, as directed by the engineer, to verify its depth.

Additionally, the Contractor is additionally directed to pothole all utility facilities that exist within the roadway widening area, as indicated by DigAlert utility markings, prior to performing any excavation, as directed by the Engineer. If the existing utility is shallow, as determined by the Engineer, the Contractor shall contact the owner of the utility and arrange for a meeting with the utility owner and the Engineer to determine the course of action so as to protect the utility in-place. All decisions and direction of the Engineer shall be considered as final. All work near and affecting shallow utility facilities within the roadway widening areas shall be performed only after providing the utility owner with at least 48 hours advance notice of such work. Full compensation for compliance with the potholing and coordination requirements of this Addendum item shall be considered as included in the various items of work, and no additional compensation will be allowed therefore."

Item 12: **Water Pollution Control (Santa Ana River Basin-Risk Level 1).** Refer to section entitled "WATER POLLUTION CONTROL (SANTA ANA RIVER BASIN-RISK LEVEL 1)" pages 62 through 68. Delete the fifth paragraph on page 64 and replace with the following paragraph:

"Within **ten (10)** working days after the award of the contract, the Contractor shall submit two (2) copies of the SWPPP/MP to the Engineer for review and approval. The Contractor shall allow **five (5)** working days for the Engineer to review the SWPPP/MP. If revisions are required as determined by the Engineer, the Contractor shall revise and resubmit the SWPPP/MP within three (3) working days of receipt of the Engineer's comments and shall allow **five (5)** working days for the Engineer to review the revisions. The Contractor shall submit four (4) copies of the approved SWPPP/MP to the Engineer prior to notice to proceed. The Contractor must have an approved SWPPP/MP prior to the notice to proceed. The Engineer may provide a letter of conditional approval of the Contractor's SWPPP/MP while minor revisions are made and may allow the Contractor to begin only those certain construction activities identified in the letter of conditional approval. In no case will the conditional approval extend beyond twenty-one (21) calendar days. The Engineer may suspend construction operations until the Contractor submits a revised SWPPP/MP that is reviewed and approved by the Engineer."

Item 13: **Portable Changeable Message Signs.** Refer to section entitled "PORTABLE CHANGEABLE MESSAGE SIGNS" pages 55 through 57. Delete the last two paragraphs and replace with the following paragraph:

"Full compensation for portable changeable message signs, including furnishing, placing, operating, modifying messages, maintaining, transporting from location to location, removing, and repairing or replacing defective or damaged portable

changeable message signs **shall be** included in the contract **lump sum** price paid for **Traffic Control System** and no separate payment will be made therefor.”
