AN URGENCY INTERIM ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 824

AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE WESTERN RIVERSIDE COUNTY
TRANSPORTATION UNIFORM MITIGATION FEE PROGRAM

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside

RIVERSIDE COUNTY
TRANSPORTATION UNIFORM MITIGATION FEE
PROGRAM
The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside
ordains as follows:
Section 1. The introductory sentence of Section 7. of
Ordinance No. \$24 is amended to read as follows:
"Section 7. TEMPORARY FEE REDUCTION PERIOD. Pursuant to the fee adjustment authority set forth
in Section 6.c. and notwithstanding Section 6.a., or any
other provision of this ordinance, the following TUMF
fee schedule shall apply for the period commencing on
January 1, 2010 and ending on January 13, 2011:
Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an
urgency measure and shall take effect immediately
upon its adoption and shall have no further force and
effect thirty (30) days after its adoption unless extended
pursuant to law. In accordance with the requirements of
Government Code section 66017, subsection (b), the
Board of Supervisors hereby declares that the provisions
contained herein are necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, welfare and safety for the
following reasons:
a. On December 31, 2010, the temporary fee reduction schedule for the TUMF program will expire; and
b. The extension of the temporary fee reduction will
reduce the overall costs of development, thereby encouraging economic growth and minimizing the ongoing
impact of the economic recession on development and
c. Absent on immediate extension of the temporary
fee reduction, permits and construction is that's anlicipated from pending development projects will either be
noted to delayed until expiration of the otherwise required thirty (30) day waiting period; and
d. WRCOG has directed the County to implement
this temporary fee reduction immediately and the
county work of the common of the program and stay eligible to receive the funds
necessary for its vital transportation projects; and
e. The loss of funds the County would suffer if it fails
to comply with WRCOG's directive would significantly
and derimmentally affect public welfare by severely limiting the County
