Contractor Questions and Responses

1	Question	The work for item 82-Structural Concrete, Retaining Wall is shown and detailed on plan sheets 174-182. Where is the work shown for item 83-Structural Concrete, Retaining Wall? The quantity is shown on sheet 217 of the bridge plans but there are no details. Is the quantity for item 83 mistakenly included with the quantity for item 82?
	Response	Item 83-Structural Concrete, Retaining Wall with a quantity of 88 M3 is a bridge item. It covers the CIP concrete facing of the tieback walls at abutments shown on Sheet 229 of 258.
2	Question	It appears the quantity for "Colored Glass Exposed Rock Median" has been included with both Item 119-Minor Concrete (Misc Construction) and Item 88-Minor Concrete (Exposed Colored Glass Rock Median Paving). Please review.
	Response	Quantity for item 88 should not be included in quantity for item 119. Quantities revised. See Addendum #1.
3	Question	Reference Summary of Quantities sheet 173, colored glass exposed rock median section of the Minor Concrete summary. Using the area quantity of 1200.5 m2 and the volume quantity of 360.2 m3 the thickness would be 0.3 M (1' thick). Is this thickness dimension correct?
	Response	The thickness for the colored glass exposed rock median should be 100mm. Quantity revised. See Addendum #1.
4	Question	The existing Date Palm Drive OH crossing the Union Pacific Railroad has a portion of the bridge deck overlayed with AC. Plans do not indicate any work to be preformed to the existing bridge deck. Is the new Date Palm Drive PCC section to meet this existing AC?
	Response	Quantities have been added for removal of existing AC for the RR OH. Polyester Concrete will be overlaid on the existing bridge deck. Details of the RR OH work are shown on sheets C-3 and sheet C-17. Quantities revised. See Addendum #1.
5	Question	Our quantity take-off for item 45-Roadway Excavation, is substantially less than the engineer's quantity of 109,000 m3. Conversely, our quantity take-off for item 54-Imported Borrow is substantially higher than the engineer's quantity of 14,400 m3. Please review.
	Response	Quantities revised. See Addendum #1.

Contractor Questions and Responses		
6	Question	Portions of the existing westbound and eastbound on-ramps are located outside of the grading limits. Are these ramps to be removed? If they are to be removed, how will this work be measured and paid?
	Response	Existing ramps outside of grading limits will remain.
7	Question	Section 10-1.72 of the Project Specifications requires that aggregate for Type C HMA is to be treated using the lime slurry method. However, Section 10-1.73 requires that aggregate for Type C HMA is to be treated using the dry lime method. Since only one method can be used, can you clarify which mandatory lime treatment method shall be used for Type C HMA. This question will significantly affect Type C HMA material pricing, so we ask the answer be incorporated into an Addenda issued to all bidders.
	Response	Contractor is to select the lime treatment method for HMA (Type C). Conform to the provisions at the top of page 239, Book 2 of 3 of the special provisions.
8	Question	Will the agency consider a postponement of the bid opening date so the plan changes made with addendum 1 can be properly analyzed?
	Response	The bid opening date has been revised by Addendum 2 and extended one week. Bidding Contractors are to anticipate this new date to be final. See Addendum #2.
9	Question	There does not appear to be a bid item for Class 2 Aggregate Subbase. How will this work be paid?
	Response	Class 2 Aggregate Subbase item added including estimated quantities. See Addendum #1.
10	Question	Addendum 1, construction detail sheet C-17, Detail 'A', shows the median on RR OH bridge deck. Will this same detail apply to the existing Date Palm Drive Overcrossing? Will both bridge medians be included with item 87 (F,B)-Minor Concrete (Exposed Colored Glass Rock Median Paving)? If both are included with item 87, the final pay quantity is severely understated.
	Response	Item 87 applies to Date Palm Drive Overcrossing only. The Exposed Colored Glass Rock Median Paving material for Date Palm RR OH is included in item 88.
11	Question	Retaining Wall RW-18 on page 177 of 258 has design heights varying from 3.6m to 10.3m. It is per CT design B3-1, however this standard drawing only goes up to H=9.1m. Please advise on what design to use for H=9.7 and H=10.3
	Response	CT Standard plan B3-2 is applicable for design heights of 9.7 to 10.3.

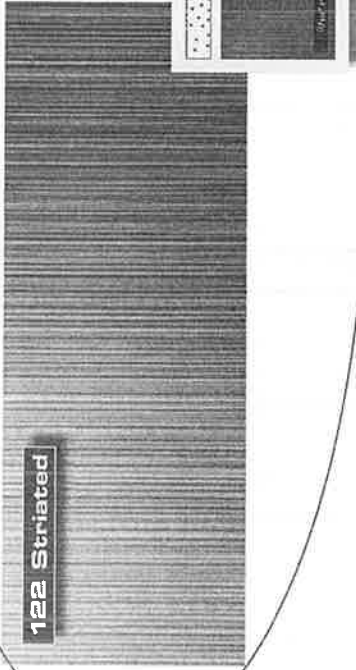

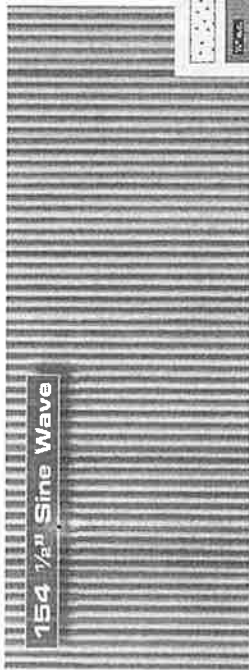

THIS AGREEMENT, made and concluded in duplicate as of the date set forth below, between the County of Riverside, party of the first part, and SEMA Construction, Inc., Contractor, party of the second part.

ARTICLE I: WITNESSETH, that for and in consideration of the payments and agreements hereinafter mentioned, to be made and performed by the said party of the first part, and under the conditions expressed in the two bonds, bearing even date with these presents, the said party of the second part agrees with the said party of the first part, at his own proper cost and expense, to do all the work and furnish all the materials, except such as are mentioned in the specifications to be furnished by said party of the first part, necessary to construct and complete in a good, workmanlike and substantial manner and to the satisfaction of the County of Riverside, in accordance with the Special Provisions, "Notice to Contractors", the State of California Department of Industrial Relations Wage Determination, the Federal Wage Determination, the Proposal to the County of Riverside for the Project, addendum No. **1 through 3**, the Bid Bond, the Performance Bond, the Payment Bond, any specific plans for the project not covered by the Standard Specifications and Standard Plans, any change orders issued, and any written instructions and drawings executed and delivered to the Contractor by the County pursuant to the Contract Documents. Also in accordance with the **Standard Plans, dated May 2006**, the **Standard Specifications, dated May 2006**, the General Prevailing Wage Rates of the Department of Transportation, with the effective date being the date of advertisement, and the Labor Surcharge and Equipment Rental Rates, with the effective date being the date of advertisement, and the Labor Surcharge and Equipment Rental Rates, with the effective date being the date of accomplishing the work, which said special provisions Standard Plans, Standard Specifications, Prevailing Wage Rates, and Labor Surcharge and Equipment Rental Rates are hereby specially referred to and by such reference, made a part hereof.

The work to be done is shown on plans entitled **State Highway in Riverside County in Cathedral City from 6.4 km East of Palm Drive/ Gene Autry Trail to 6.2 km West of Ramon Road**. Project Sheets 1 through 258, approved May 19, 2010 on file with the County Surveyor file No.206-372 through 629, and as revised by addenda, which said project plans are hereby made a part of this contract.

ARTICLE II: The said party of the first part hereby promises and agrees with the said Contractor to employ, and does hereby employ, the said Contractor to provide the materials and to do the work according to the terms and conditions herein contained and referred to, for the prices hereinafter set forth, and hereby contracts to pay the same at the

time, in the manner and upon the conditions herein set forth; and the said parties for themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, do hereby agree to the full performance of the covenants herein contained.

ARTICLE III: The statement of prevailing wages appearing in the General Prevailing Wage Rates is hereby specifically referred to and by this reference is made a part of this contract. It is further expressly agreed by and between the parties hereto that should there be any conflict between the terms of this instrument and the bid or proposal of said Contractor, then this instrument shall control and nothing herein shall be considered as an acceptance of the said terms of said proposal conflicting herewith.

ARTICLE IV: By my signature hereunder, as Contractor, I certify that I am aware of the provisions of Section 3700 of the Labor Code which require every employer to be insured against liability for workmen's compensation or to undertake self-insurance in accordance with the provisions of that code and I will comply with such provisions before commencing the performance of the work of this contract.

ARTICLE V: And the said Contractor agrees to receive and accept the following prices as full compensation for furnishing all materials and for doing all the work contemplated and embraced in this agreement; also for all loss or damage, arising out of the nature of the work aforesaid, or from the action of the elements, or from any unforeseen difficulties or obstructions which may arise or be encountered in the prosecution of the work until its acceptance by the County of Riverside, and for all risks of every description connected with the work; also for all expenses incurred by or in consequence of the suspension or discontinuance of work and for well and faithfully completing the work, and the whole thereof, in the manner and according to the plans and specifications, and the requirements of the Engineer under them, to wit:
