#### **BACKGROUND:**

An Off Highway Vehicle (OHV) Commission was established in 2006 under the Riverside County Planning Department to advise and make recommendation to the Board of Supervisors concerning the identification of sites for OHV parks, site acquisition issues, range and use of candidate sites, and advice on public outreach for educational and informational purposes. The duration of the OHV Commission and its members' terms ended December 31, 2010, per M.O. 3.9, January 13, 2009.

As such, through Resolution 2011-7, the District recommends that an Off Highway Vehicle Recreation (OHVR) Commission be established under the District to serve in an advisory capacity to the District Board of Directors. It is also recommended that the recent members who served on the previous OHV Commission be appointed to now serve under the newly established OHVR Commission.

The purpose of the OHVR Commission will be to assist with planning, acquiring and developing for use off-highway vehicle parks within the County and District boundaries, as well as assisting with public outreach for the District.

Pursuant to Res. No. 2011-6 attached hereto, Board Policy A-21 will serve as By-laws for both District Commissions. Res. No. 2011-8 updates and clarifies the District Advisory Commission's formation resolution.

# Adopting and Incorporating Riverside County Board of Supervisors' Policy A-21 as Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District Policies

WHEREAS, the Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District ("District") is established pursuant to Public Resources Code section 5506.7 and;

WHEREAS, Riverside County has promulgated a Board of Supervisor's Policy Manual to guide Riverside County functions;

WHEREAS, District functions closely correspond to County functions in certain respects:

WHEREAS, the District operates most efficiently and effectively by following certain County Policies.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District, in regular session assembled on <a href="February 15">February 15</a>, 2011 that the Riverside County Board of Supervisors Policy A-21 is hereby adopted by reference and is incorporated as District Policy A-21 in the District Policy Manual.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the operation of the District and the District boards, commissions and committees shall be in compliance with the procedures prescribed in Riverside County Board of Supervisors Policy A-21 as may be amended from time to time, and with the specific provisions delineated below in this Resolution.

- 1. District Policy A-21 shall replace references to the "Board of Supervisors" with "Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District Board of Directors" as appropriate to effectuate the purpose of this Resolution.
- 2. District Policy A-21 shall replace references to "County of Riverside" with "District" as appropriate to effectuate the purpose of this Resolution.

### RESOLUTION No. 2011-7

## Establishing the Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District Off-Highway Vehicle Recreation Commission

WHEREAS, the Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District ("District") is established pursuant to Public Resources Code section 5506.7 and;

WHEREAS, the District may regulate Off-Highway Vehicles ("OHV") within the District pursuant to Public Resources Code section 5558 and;

WHEREAS, the District may plan, acquire, develop, control and operate District parks and open-space areas pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 5541 and 5541.2 and:

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes the need to establish a commission to analyze, advise, and make recommendations to the District Board of Directors concerning the planning, acquisition, development and use of OHV parks within the District.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on February 15 2011 that the Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District Off-Highway Vehicle Recreation Commission ("OHVR Commission") is hereby created.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the operation of the OHVR Commission shall be in compliance with the rules, regulations and procedures prescribed in Riverside County Board of Directors Policy A-21 and with the specific provisions delineated below in this Resolution.

2. MEMBERS: The OHVR Commission shall consist of five (5) members, each of whom shall be appointed and serve at the pleasure of the Board of Directors. All appointees shall be at least 18 years of age, shall reside within Riverside County, and shall serve without compensation, except for mileage at approved Riverside County reimbursement rates to attend scheduled meetings.

Initial Members Shall Include:

- ii. Jon Christensen
- iii. Anthony Mig liore
- iv. Ryan Stendell
- v. Meg Grossglass
- 3. TERMS: The terms of the OHVR Commission members shall be for not less than two (2) years and not more than (4) four years from the last preceding July 1 at the Board of Directors' discretion, shall expire on an alternating basis, and may be renewed for successive terms.
- 5. SECRETARY: The Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District General Manager, or his/her designee, shall serve as Secretary of the OHVR Commission and shall be responsible for performing the duties specified in Board of Directors Policy A-21.
- 6. MEETINGS: The OHVR Commission shall meet no less than four (4) times a year, with the primary meeting place to be the Riverside County Regional

### **RESOLUTION No. 2011-8**

# Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space **District Advisory Commission**

WHEREAS, the Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District

("District") is established pursuant to Public Resources Code section 5506.7; and WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District approved Resolutions No. 94-3 and 2005-3 ("Formation"

Resolutions") establishing a Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District Advisory Commission to advise District development pursuant to Public Resources

WHEREAS subsequent changes to Board policies regarding advisory committees, boards and commissions necessitate revisions to the Formation Resolutions and the Regional Park and Open-Space District Advisory Commission's Bylaws.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Riverside County Regional Park and Open-Space District, State of California, in regular session assembled on February 15 2011, that all previous Formation Resolutions and Bylaws pertaining to the Commission are hereby rescinded.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the operation of the Commission shall be in compliance with the rules, regulations and procedures

prescribed in Riverside County Board of Directors Policy A-21 ("Policy A-21") and with the specific provisions as stated herein.

- 1. PURPOSE: It shall be the purpose of the Riverside County
  Regional Park and Open-Space District Advisory Commission ("Commission") to advise
  and make recommendations to the Board of Directors concerning the planning,
  acquisition, development and use of parks and open space for a comprehensive system
  of parks and open space for the County of Riverside. The Commission is further
  charged to advise and recommend to the Board of Directors the most economical and
  efficient method for the acquisition, development, maintenance, and promotion of
  regional recreation trails.
- 2. MEMBERS: The Commission shall consist of 11 members, each of whom shall be appointed and serve at the pleasure of the Board of Directors. All appointees shall be at least 18 years of age, shall reside within the Riverside County, and shall serve without compensation, except for mileage at approved Riverside County reimbursement rates to attend scheduled meetings. The Board of Directors shall appoint two members to represent each of the five supervisorial districts, except the Director who represents the Fourth District shall appoint three members, one of whom shall represent the Colorado River Valley portion of the County to include the area surrounding the City of Blythe.
- 3. TERMS: The terms of the Commission members shall be for not less than two years and not more than four years from the last preceding July 1, shall expire on an alternating basis, and may be renewed for successive terms.

- 4. OFFICERS: At the first regular meeting on or after July 1 of each year, the Commission shall elect a Chair and Vice Chair as specified in Board Policy A-21, who shall perform the duties specified therein.
- 5. SECRETARY: The General Manager of the Regional Park and Open-Space District, or his/her designee, shall serve as Secretary of the Commission and shall be responsible for performing the duties specified in Board Policy A-21.
- 6. MEETINGS: The Commission shall meet bi-monthly, with the primary meeting place to be the Regional Park and Open-Space District headquarters, with alternate meeting locations at publicly accessible facilities within District boundaries as determined by the Commission.
- 7. GOVERNANCE: The Commission shall be bound and governed by the provisions of the Ralph M. Brown Act, Board Policy A-21, and all other applicable Resolutions, laws, ordinances, rules, and District policies.
- 8. SUPERCESSION: This Resolution shall replace and supersede all previous enabling resolutions.
- 9. <u>BOARD POLICY NO. A-21</u>. The provisions of Riverside
  County Board of Directors Policy No. A-21 entitled "Adopting Uniform Rules and
  Procedures for Advisory Committees, Boards and Commissions of the County of
  Riverside" are incorporated herein to this resolution by reference, and are intended as
  guidance for the Commission in carrying out its duties.
