BACKGROUND: On May 4, 2010, the County Board of Supervisors approved Agenda Item 3.59 authorizing the submittal of the California Volunteers State Homeland Security Grant application and designating Authorized Agents to oversee the grant for an amount up to \$150,000.

The California Volunteers Commission has chosen OES as one of the grant recipients and has awarded funding in the amount of \$231,000, \$81,000 more than originally requested. Theses funds will allow OES to develop, expand and enhance state and local governments' ability to use disaster volunteers through first aid and CPR training, background checks for up to 200 disaster corps volunteers and the purchase of pertinent supplies, equipment, training, exercise and planning activities. Further, it will provide funding for three staffing positions for a period of 11 months who will facilitate these duties.

The grant term is through February 28, 2012 and will be included in the OES FY11/12 budget.
