BACKGROUND: (continued)

Relocation to a new facility is predicated on the availability of State funding, which won't be known for several months. However, in order to position ourselves to utilize this funding should it be available, it is recommended that a search for potential developers be initiated at this time. A new lease will not be submitted to the Board for approval unless sufficient funding is identified to support the relocation and ongoing cost for operations.

DPSS has identified this project as a priority due to the ongoing facility problems at the current DHS location and the desire to establish a full Self Sufficiency office that will better serve the residents from DHS and the immediate surrounding areas.

The current facility and operation in DHS is described below:

GAIN – 15 staff 14-201 Palm Drive 3,546 square feet

After an exhaustive search for an existing office, DPSS is seeking to join other county services located on Palm Drive near Park Lane across the street from our present location. A developer needs to be identified to purchase 2.5 acres and build a 25,000 square feet office that would be leased to DPSS.
