

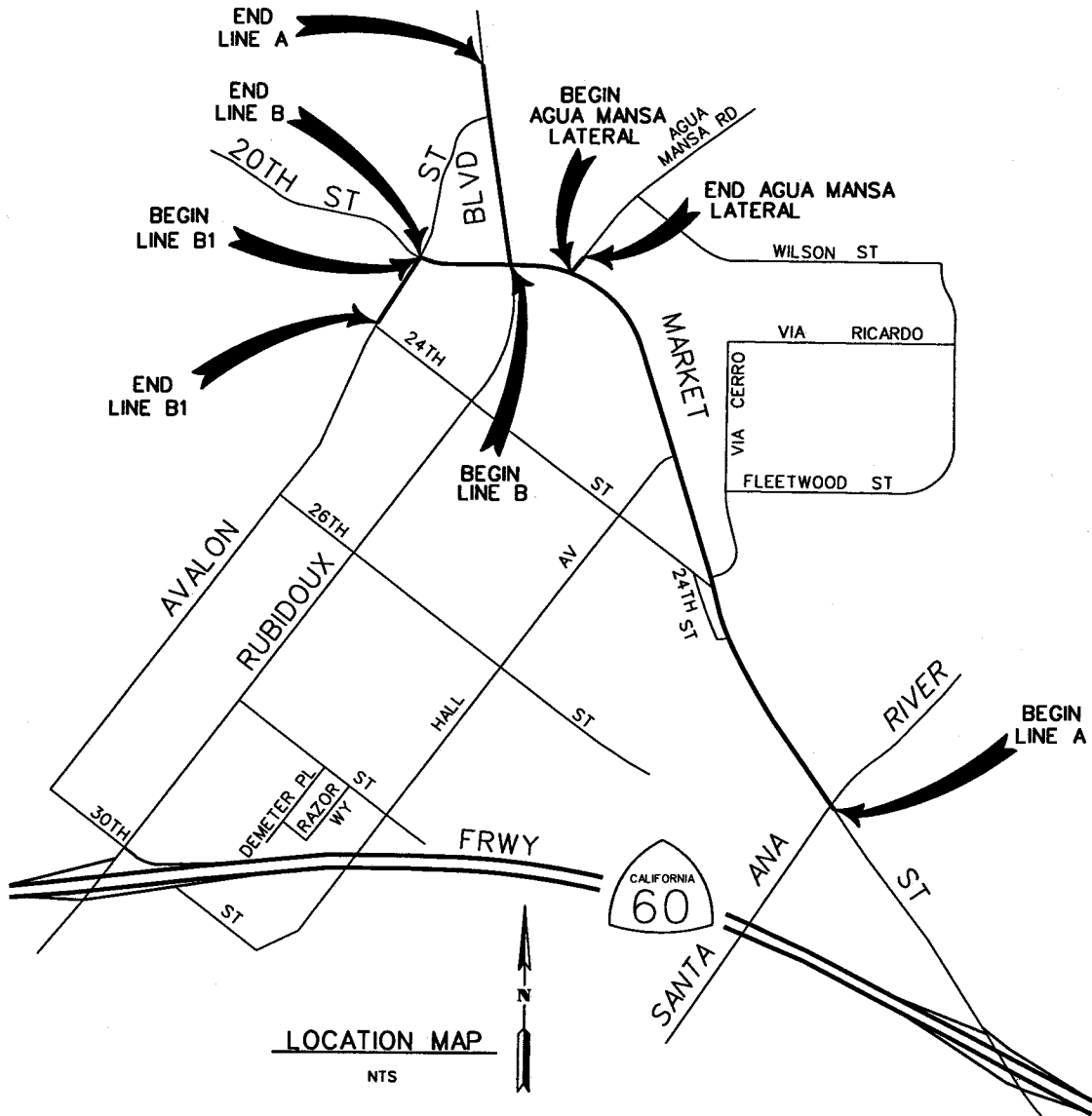

BELLTOWN MARKET STREET STORM DRAIN STAGE 1 LINE A, LINE B, LINE B-1



The proposed project is located within the unincorporated Belltown community of Riverside County northerly of the City of Riverside. The alignment of the drainage facilities will specifically be located along Rubidoux Boulevard, Agua Mansa Road, Avalon, 20th and Market Streets, and connecting to the Santa Ana River Channel. The project consists of the construction of approximately 4,900 lineal feet of 11 feet wide by 7 feet high reinforced concrete box (RCB), approximately 3,000 lineal feet of mainline storm drain ranging from 36 inch to 84 inch diameter, approximately 1,000 lineal feet of connector pipe storm drain ranging from 18 inch to 48 inch diameter, two major inlet structures, a porous landscape detention water quality feature and a major outlet structure adjacent to and outletting into the Santa Ana River Channel.
