

SUBJECT: Desert Alliance for Community Empowerment

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors adopt Resolution No. 2011-067, withdrawing as a member of the Desert Alliance for Community Empowerment (DACE) Board of Directors

BACKGROUND: The County of Riverside applied for and received a federal empowerment zone designation over a 744 square mile area of the Eastern Coachella Valley. In order to manage that empowerment zone, the DACE was formed and established as a California nonprofit public benefit 501(c) 3 IRS tax exempt corporation. The County of Riverside participated with DACE as a member of its Board of Directors. The federal empowerment zone designation expired by the terms of its enabling legislation on December 31, 2010. As such, the County of Riverside now proposes to withdraw from the DACE Board of Directors.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2011-067

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING EXPIRATION OF THE FEDERAL EMPOWERMENT ZONE DESIGNATION FOR THE DESERT ALLIANCE FOR COMMUNITY EMPOWERMENT

- I. WHEREAS, the County of Riverside applied for and received a federal empowerment zone designation over a 744 square mile area of the Eastern Coachella Valley including parts of census tract numbers 456.01, 456.02, 458 and 459;
- II. WHEREAS, subsequent to the to the creation of the empowerment zone, the Desert Alliance for Community Empowerment (DACE) was formed and established as a California nonprofit public benefit 501(c) 3 IRS tax exempt corporation;
- III. WHEREAS, the County of Riverside has participated with DACE as a member of its board of directors represented by the Fourth District Supervisor since its inception;
- IV. WHEREAS, the empowerment zone operated successfully since 1999 under the management of DACE;
- V. WHEREAS, participation by the County of Riverside on the DACE board of directors was necessary during such period designation;
- VI. WHEREAS, the federal empowerment zone designation expired by the terms of its enabling legislation on 31 December 2010;
- VII. WHEREAS, continued participation by the County of Riverside on the DACE board of directors, without management of a designated empowerment zone, may present a conflict of interest; and
- VIII. WHEREAS, Supervisor Benoit, Fourth District Supervisor, wishes to continue to support DACE.

- 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
