

**BACKGROUND:** The Coachella Valley Water District Weather Based Pilot Program was created in 2005. The water conservation program has been hugely successful. According to CVWD findings, there has been average savings of 131 gallons per day per clock, and overall savings of 26% over the control group.

The Valley Crime Stoppers is having the 24<sup>th</sup> Annual Crimestoppers Golf Tournament on April 22. Valley Crime Stoppers offers rewards for anonymous information concerning individuals involved in crime. To date the organization has paid out over \$115,000 dollars and has recovered stolen property and contraband totaling over 17 million dollars.

The Riverside County Regional Medical Center's 2011 Spring Garden Tour will take place on May 7<sup>th</sup>. The goal is to raise over \$40,000 to support the Child Abuse and Neglect Unit at RCRMC.

The Debbie Chisholm Memorial Foundation's 15<sup>th</sup> Annual Cops and Kids Charity Golf Tournament will take place on April 30<sup>th</sup>. The event will raise funds to provide wishes to kids that are ill and to provide assistance to families of police officers killed or injured in the line of duty.
