
RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

BACKGROUND:


On February 8, 2011, Agenda Item No. 3.26, the Board of Supervisors approved the Agreement with Thermal Rite for repair of the refrigeration system in the Food Services Department at Riverside County Regional Medical Center. The Agreement was for the repair of four built-in walk-in coolers and one built-in walk-in freezer. Upon inspection of the equipment, it was determined that four doors were non-repairable and require replacement. This Amendment adds the cost of \$5,800 to the existing Agreement for replacement of the doors.


