While living in Murrieta, he formed the Extra Years of Zest (XYZ) Club and was instrumental in the establishment of a local senior center.

Ordained in 1953, David served as a pastor in rural Iowa and Wisconsin, where he built a "modern church" that continues to serve a thriving community. In Michigan and California, his efforts led to the "flourishing" of the "Church in the Marketplace" which sponsors communities that lift up the lives of disaffected youth and neglected senior citizens. He also worked as a minister of music and pastoral consultant in Temecula while conducting extensive visitation of seniors in their place of need.

David was a loving husband, father, and friend whose memory and generous spirit will live forever in the hearts of those who knew and loved him. He will be deeply missed.
