SUBJECT: Resolution 2011-5, Use Fees for the Riverside County Regional Park & Open-Space District, effective July 1, 2011

BACKGROUND: The proposed use fees for FY 2011-12 reflect fee increases made necessary to cover expenses in many categories. The District followed Policy J-5, and compared rates with over five (5) different agencies in Southern California. This comparison resulted in a clear analysis that the District was charging substantially lower fees in many areas than comparable agencies. District staff took this comparison data and reviewed the costs to provide services. The increases in fees will recover costs incurred in providing District services that have not been met by current fees.

The changes incorporated into Resolution 2011-5 have been reviewed and approved by the District Advisory Commission at its meeting on January 6, 2011.

It is requested that your Honorable Board approve said changes and adopt Resolution 2011-5, Use Fees for the District effective July 1, 2011.
