**SUBJECT:** 5<sup>th</sup> DISTRICT USE OF CFB-COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DESIGNATION FUNDS

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Approve the use of CFB-Community Improvement Designation funds for \$10,000.
- 2) Approve and direct the Auditor-Controller to make the following budget adjustments:

**BACKGROUND:** From July 2009 through June 2010, 80,000 acres burned within the CAL FIRE jurisdictional responsibility area. 121 homes were destroyed and 40 were damaged. In May, 2010, the Ready! Set! Go! Wildfire Action Plan was launched to assist residents whose homes border "Wildland Urban Interface" (WUI) areas on how to "harden" their homes and prepare their families for evacuation in the event of an approaching wildfire. The goal of the Ready! Set! Go! Wildfire Action Plan is to provide a full understanding of the threat and impact of wildland fires, along with steps that residents can take to assist firefighters in defending their homes. Riverside County Fire Department has prepared a brochure about the ever-present threat of wildland fires and to stress the importance of year-round awareness. Printing and distribution of "Ready! Set! Go!" brochures at community events, safety fairs and fire stations is a key component in this education program and these funds will assist in that effort. I urge the Board of Supervisors to approve this use of CFB-Community Improvement Designation funds.
