On motion of Supervisor Benoit, seconded by Supervisor Buster, and duly carried by unanimous vote, IT WAS ORDERED that the meeting of Monday, June 13, 2011, is adjourned in memory of Ron Meepos, an 80-year-old resident and Mayor Pro Tem of the City of Rancho Mirage, serving on the council since 2002.

Enlisting in the Army during the Korean war, Ron was a patriot and public servant who was dedicated to his country and community. After retiring to Rancho Mirage in 1996, his work with the Mission Hills Homeowners' Association and local nonprofits led to his first council run in 2002. Ron also served on several regional boards and started Rancho Mirage's "Residential Golf Program" which gives residents fee discounts on rounds of golf at the Westin Mission Hills Resort and also brings in a profit for the city.

Ron was a devoted and loving family man who will always be remembered for his "commitment to improving the lives of the people he served" and for his "work which will benefit the city of Rancho Mirage for many decades to come." His memory and gentle spirit will live forever in the hearts of those who knew him. He will be deeply missed.

The Board of Supervisors commemorates his service to the County of Riverside.
