AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 452

RELATING TO PRIMA FACIE SPEED LIMITS The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside ordings as follows:

Section 1. Section 2.3 of Ordinance No. 452, entitled "

"103. On Algarve Avenue between the centerline
of SH 79/Winchester Road and the centerline of Skyview Road, a total distance of approximately 0.66 miles, in the Murrieta area.

Subsection 13 of Section 2.2 of Ordinance No. 452 adopted on October 26, 2004, pursuant to Ordinance No. 452.219 is repealed in its entirety. Subsection 13 of Section 2.2 established a thirty miles per hour speed limit on Jameson Road between Clay Canyon Drive and Camino Limon Road.
