BACKGROUND:

The Coachella Valley Conservation Commission (CVCC) has prepared a new Nexus Study dated May 2011 and has requested that the County process an amendment to the County's fee ordinance for the Coachella Valley Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (CVMSHCP). The nexus study concluded that the existing mitigation fee should be reduced accordingly as shown in the table below.
