Background: Continued

The California Emergency Management Agency (Cal EMA) requires all grant applicants to obtain and maintain written authorization from the Board of Supervisors identifying titles of official(s) authorized to sign and execute the Grant Award Face Sheet (Cal EMA 2-101), all amendments to the Grant Award, and the Certification of Assurance of Compliance (Cal EMA 2-104) for grant applications submitted.

Obligated county funds are specifically budgeted in the current fiscal year, or there are no obligated county funds for the grant. Any resulting grant awards from an application will be brought to the Board for review and decision to accept the funds once reviewed and approved as to form by County Counsel.
