BACKGROUND (Continued)

The Riverside County Gang Reduction Intervention and Prevention (RivCoGRIP) Program is a pilot project targeting 60 youth at-risk of gang involvement, gang involved or current gang members in the Jurupa Valley. If the pilot program is successful and based on future funding opportunities, the program may be replicated county-wide.

Program participants will be served at the Rubidoux Youth Opportunity Center. The Youth Opportunity Center (YOC) serves as a "One-Stop" for low income youth to receive employment and training services. Through CalGRIP, the Rubidoux YOC will expand services to provide a comprehensive community-based intervention and prevention program. The program will address individual, family, peer, community and school risk factors that contribute to gang involvement. Services will include: Youth and Leadership Development; Mentoring; Academic Instruction and Support; Job Development and Training, Supportive Services; and Follow-up Services.

The project will engage youth in positive community alternatives, increase their vocational and job readiness skills and link them to career pathways, with the ultimate goal to connect the youth to unsubsidized employment in a high wage/high growth industry. The duration of the program will cover 22 months beginning March 1, 2011 through December 31, 2012.
