BACKGROUND: (Continued)

The CSAC Excess Insurance Authority rules and regulations require the Housing Authority of the County of Riverside (HACR), to designate a person to represent the HACR in matters such as: approval to use loss prevention or risk management subsidy funds; how to receive dividend or "no claims bonus" funds; how to proceed with premium adjustments; approval to enter into service arrangements; execution of any official documents such as MOUs; and HACR's vote for the public entity representatives to serve on the CSAC Excess Insurance Authority Board of Directors.

DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE RISK MANAGER TO ACT ON BEHALF OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE

WHEREAS, the CSAC Excess Insurance Authority (Authority) has determined that it is necessary for each member of the Authority to delegate a person[s] or position[s] authority to act on the member's behalf in matters relating to the member and the Authority; and

WHEREAS, except as to those actions that must be approved by the Housing Authority Board of Commissioners, such delegation of authority is necessary in order to carry out the purposes and functions of the Authority with its members; and

WHEREAS, in order to ensure a person[s] or position[s] is delegated with authority to act on the member's behalf in matters relating to the member and the Authority, action by the member's governing body is necessary; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Housing Authority Board of Commissioners as follows:

Except as to actions that must be approved by the Housing Authority Board of Commissioners, the County of Riverside Risk Manager is hereby appointed to act in all matters relating to the member and the Authority.
