
SUBJECT: Support for California State Assembly Bill 939 (V. Manuel Perez)

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Support the passage of Assembly Bill 939 (V. Manuel Perez)
2. Direct county legislative advocates in Sacramento to support AB 939
3. Authorize appropriate county staff to testify in support of AB 939 as necessary or requested by the bill's author
4. Support amendments to the bill that are of mutual benefit to parties of interest

BACKGROUND:

AB 939 would transfer to the local Salton Sea Authority, of which the county is a voting member, the mandate, authority and responsibilities of the Salton Sea Restoration Council. The bill in its current form does require friendly modifying amendments in some sections, and attempts will be made by elected and appointed county staff to seek author approval for amendments as needed.
